A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday's celebration of Pentecost is also called the birthday of the Church. This is because it was not until the Holy Spirit was poured out upon the Apostles that they had the strength to carry out the mission Christ had entrusted them with, namely to bring the Good News of Jesus to the whole earth.

The Holy Spirit empowered the Apostles to overcome their fears and boldly proclaim Jesus to those who did not know Him. The same Spirit inspired, guided and directed the growth of the early Church according to the plan of God. Without the Holy Spirit, the Apostles only had their own meager resources. With the Spirit, they received abundant power and grace which allowed them to do more they could ever imagine.

As Christians, Pentecost reminds us of the importance of praying to the Holy Spirit regularly. It is through the Holy Spirit that we grow in our friendship with God. The Holy Spirit expands the desire for God within our hearts and encourages us to seek out grace. The Holy Spirit also causes us to grow in charity, helping us to love others and God more authentically and consistently.

Scripture assures us that we will be given an outpouring of The Holy Spirit to the degree we want such an outpouring. How much do we want the Holy Spirit to come alive in us? How much do we want our lives to be led by the Holy Spirit rather than by our own whims and thoughts? What kind of difference can one believer, filled with the Holy Spirit, make in the life of a parish? What about the presence of several or many such believers? For the past year, St. Peter's has been encouraging members to consider making a Cursillo (pronounced Cur-see-yo) in order to deepen their relationship with God. Getting involved in this experience and coming to Ultreya meeting here in the parish monthly will certainly increase your desire for the Holy Spirit!

This Pentecost weekend, we congratulate our deacon-intern, John McManamon, who received the Sacrament of Holy Orders from Bishop McManus at the Cathedral Saturday. We pray for him as he begins his ministry in our parish, that the Holy Spirit may fill his heart and guide and protect him in the years ahead.




Parishioners who would like to receive the sacrament are asked to move to the front pews after Mass concludes.
