

A Note From Father Míchael

Dear Friends in Christ,

Several weeks ago, two groups of teenagers fought on the Whitinsville town common and one teen died while another was seriously injured. Last week, a statement from the Northbridge Association of Churches concerning this violence was included in our bulletin. This sad episode in our community history reminds us that yes, such events CAN happen here and that we must take time to reflect upon them in light of our Catholic Faith.

The Ten Commandments form the basis of Christian morality. Revealed by God to Moses in Old Testament times, The Ten Commandments are moral prescriptions which govern human life on earth and reveal God's plan for society and it's well-being. In John 14:15, Jesus makes it clear to His disciples that "if you love me, you will keep my commandments." Therefore, we cannot claim to love God if we disregard God's moral laws and act selfishly and without charity towards our neighbor.

How many people today, if asked, could tell us what The Ten Commandments are? How well have new generations been taught the moral truths of Christianity and learned how to live them well? The Fifth Commandment teaches us "Thou shalt not kill." This commandment teaches us that human life is sacred from conception to natural death.

As disciples of Jesus, God calls us to bring the Good News of the gospel to all, especially those who have never heard it. The saving message of Christ's love helps to turn hearts away from wrath and helps people to see that killing is not a solution to hatred. How are we called to bring the gospel into our community in a new and relevant way?

As we observe Memorial Day this Monday, let us pray for our nation. We, as American people, must not forget the moral principles God has given us in Scripture and Tradition. Our strength as a country depends upon the strength of our moral lives. May we live our faith in our society well and teach new generations its truths.
