A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday we celebrate Father's Day. As we do so, we reflect upon our fathers, grandfathers and those who have acted as fathers to us. We recognize their contributions to our lives and the ways that they have helped us to become the people we are today.

No reflection upon Father's Day would be complete without our consideration of God the Father and St. Joseph, the foster father of Our Lord. As Christians, we remember that God the Father created us out of nothing for a distinct purpose, giving us His Only Son as a sacrifice for our sins. Each day we speak to God in the prayer Jesus taught us, the Our Father. As Jesus invited His disciples to join Him in seeing God as their Father and addressing Him this way in prayer, so we consider that God the Father seeks closeness with us, His beloved children, whom we become through Baptism. 


