

A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

In Scripture, we meet figures of great faith, some of whom remain nameless to us. The gospel writers focus on their disposition, character and quality of their prayer rather than their proper names because it is these prior details that really matter.

In this Sunday's gospel, we meet two figures of great faith: the woman afflicted with hemorrhages and the synagogue official. What was so great about the faith of these two people?

The woman afflicted with hemorrhages persevered in faith despite the fact that her medical condition was worsening. She had endured much suffering and disappointment but continued to believe in God and seek His merciful healing love. This woman's faith empowered her to seek Jesus, confident that if she met Him and touched His garment, she would be healed. Her actions showed trust in God's care for her despite the fact that her affliction had lasted for years.

The synagogue official's request of the Lord was motivated by love. This man's faith was strong and bold, leading him to meet Jesus personally and tell him what he needed in a direct and courageous way. The strength of the synagogue official's faith was proven when, despite the fact that his daughter had died, he remained with Jesus, heeding His directive to "just have faith." Both the synagogue official and the sick woman saw the end result of their great faith, namely physical healing and the dead being raised to new life.

Both the woman afflicted with hemorrhages and the synagogue official can teach us how to grow deeper in our friendship with Jesus. They show us what mature Christian faith looks like and invite us to remain open to God's grace so that our faith can grow.

As we prepare to celebrate the anniversary of our nation's independence this week, may the great faith of the people of the Bible remind us of faith's value and its important role in the character-building of the American people.
