A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus' opponents observe Him carefully trying to find a reason to denounce Him to the authorities. Jesus had just walked on water and healed many sick people. But, these wonders were not enough for Jesus' opponents. They refused faith in Him and sought to denounce Him as a fraud.

Jesus' response to His opponents gives us a lot to think about. He quotes the words of the Prophet Isaiah against them telling them that they were worshipping God in vain. Why would Jesus say this?

It was because they were focused on the wrong things!
As the people were overly concerned with external observances, Jesus tried to redirect them toward what was truly important, namely conversion of heart. In Mark 7:21, Jesus gave His listeners a warning about not staying in touch with their hearts, telling them that if they failed to recognize their sinfulness that they would contribute to the overall evil in the world.

Let's think about the people we observe. What are we looking for in them? The right things or the wrong things? Do we focus on the good they have within them or in the good they do or are we apt to find fault with them, being critical and judgmental? As we observe others, do we see ourselves? Are we aware of our own sinfulness and need for conversion?

As we celebrate Labor Day this Monday, we reflect upon our journey with the Lord this year. How do we need to grow in our friendship with Jesus and in our relationships with others? How can we train ourselves to look for the right things in others so that we are more likely to see Jesus alive within them? May this upcoming Fall be a special time of grace for us all.



St. Peter's will warmly welcome Fr. Augustine Owusu, of the Diocese of Gaborone as this year's Propagation of The Faith Mission Co-Operative visiting priest.

Fr. Owusu will be speaking to us about the missionary activities of his Religious community. Their efforts of evangelization involve many humanitarian activities, namely, care for Remote Area Dwellers, commonly known as "Bushmen". They also care for orphans and vulnerable children (OVC), and a number of pre-schools for children and the disadvantaged. They run two clinics for the disadvantaged and continue to provide social services to people. They operate five primary schools in addition to one senior secondary school.

There will be a second collection the weekend of September 7th & 8th to help support the people of Botswana, Africa.
