## A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend's gospel presents to us an important reflection on 'hardness of heart.' Jesus tells His opponents that 'hardness of heart' is the reason why the Law was composed as it was by Moses.

But, what is 'hardness of heart'? Another way of describing it is stubbornness. The opposite of hardness of heart is openness of heart, meaning that one is ready to accept God's graces and love freely and authentically. The gospel shows us that stubbornness or selfishness is the death of human relationships. When we act selfishly and with little to no charity, we are unable to sustain the healthy connections we have with others.

Jesus came to free us from 'heart-hardness.' This condition is the result of sin and prevents us from receiving from the Lord the gifts, strength and joy He wants for us. Sometimes individual hurts we have experienced harden our hearts as well. We are afraid to trust, to enter into relationship, to reach out. Hurts also make us preoccupied by them. This leads us to losing focus on what is truly important.

This weekend, we begin again our Prayer Partners program. The goal of this program is to engage all parishioners of St. Peter's in regularly praying for students and families enrolled in our parish religious education program. Prayer is the highest form of charity we can exercise. When we pray for our students and families we show them our care and concern. We also ask God to keep them strong in faith and open to grace.

May we open our hearts to receive God's grace more abundantly in this new year of faith-formation and parish life. Last week's ministry fair showed us the variety of ministries our parish has and encouraged us to support them through our involvement. May our charity help others to know the presence of Christ with them always.

We ask that you do not leave items outside by the door at the parish hall or rectory. Please call the parish office if you would like to donate items at another time.


Please do not donate Christmas trees, electronics, computers, monitors, furniture, fitness equipment, records, VHS, cassette tapes, DVDs and luggage.


Everyone is welcome to attend!
