

## A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King of The Universe is celebrated annually on the Last Sunday of Ordinary Time and ends the Church's Liturgical Year. On this Sunday, we reflect upon Christ's lordship over us, the world and the entire universe. But, what exactly does the "lordship" or "kingship" of the Lord really mean? We in the United States are used to a representative form of government in which we elect our leaders and there are legal checks and balances to their power as well as term limits on their office. However, this form of government is relatively new in the history of society. A more ancient form of government, known by Jesus and the people of His times, is kingship. It is this model of rule of which Jesus was familiar and which He noted in Scripture.

Kings and emperors, in Jesus' time, were largely absolute in their powers. Their desires and wishes for their nations were carried out dutifully by their governments, often even if these were self-seeking. Good monarchs provided stability and happiness for their people while bad ones often led their nations into misery and decline. The period of rule monarchs enjoyed often is referred to as a "reign."

When we speak of Jesus as King of our hearts, the world and the universe, we are referring to His divinity and His absolute control of time and history as God. When Christians have faith in Christ, they submit their lives to Him, allowing Him to have control over what they do. This means Jesus' teachings govern Christians' actions and because these teachings further God's love and concern for the world, we say that faithful Christians extend God's reign by the way they live.

On this Feast of Christ the King, let us allow Jesus to rule over us more completely. Let us allow Our Lord to truly be our King, directing the way that we live so that we act more charitably and morally. In this way, we further God's reign over the world more fully.


