

A Note From Father Míchael

Dear Friends in Christ,

Last weekend at all Masses, we began our 'Ministry of The Month' series which will highlight a different parish ministry monthly for parishioners to learn about. We began the series inviting parishioners to ask the Holy Spirit in prayer how God might be calling them to get more actively involved in the life of our parish.

About 2 years ago, I volunteered to serve as a parish greeter. In my time as a member of St. Peter's, this ministry had not existed, but I thought it was wonderful that Father Michael was implementing it. When I initially volunteered, I did not think much of it. I envisioned a simple job of opening doors, greeting the members of our parish when they came to Mass, and passing out weekly bulletins. Over time, however, I saw that this simple job has a much deeper meaning to the members of our parish. It's not just opening doors; it's a chance to be the first warm "hello" a person may have that morning. It's not just greeting people who come through the door,

it's about connecting with our long-time community members and welcoming people who might be new. It's not just handing out bulletins, it's about being willing to share bits of information about why our parish is so special. Several times each month, I get up and make the drive to church extra early to be ready to serve as a parish greeter. It's a modest ministry that has hidden, unseen value, but one I have come to truly treasure in the years I have been part of it.
