A Note From Father Míchael

Dear Friends in Christ,

As we enter mid-February, we consider that Ash Wednesday is only several weeks away. Our parish is already planning for the new liturgical season and is excited to offer several opportunities for spiritual enrichment for the community.

Our first opportunity begins this month but will continue throughout Lent, namely The Search series offered by our RE Coordinator, Louise Forget. This Adult Faith Formation group will begin meeting on Tuesday, February 18th and will continue meeting for 7 consecutive weeks. This series offers members of the community time to deepen their friendship with Christ in a group context.

Our second opportunity is a parish Day of Reflection, being offered from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm on Saturday, March 8th on Christian Discipleship in The Gospel of St. Mark. The day will include Mass and a light lunch. Our third opportunity is to participate in Stations of The Cross on Friday evenings through Lent, at 6:30pm, led by Deacon John. On several occasions throughout Lent, Stations will be followed by a simple supper and faith enrichment sessions. More details will follow. Our fourth opportunity is to participate in the Diocesan Men's Conference, being held at the DCU center on Saturday, April 5th. Roger Guerin is our parish representative and will be speaking with us about the Conference in the weeks to come. Sign-up sheets for the conference will soon be available in the church gathering area.

Our fifth opportunity is already being offered in the parish and that is Scripture Study on Wednesday evenings at 7:00 pm. Join a dynamic group of Catholics who study the gospel for the coming Sunday, share reflections and offer prayer. Perhaps you have never tried bible study before or perhaps you have but were not able to "get into it" at the time. Our group is open to everyone seeking to deepen their friendship with God through His Word with all kinds of backgrounds and levels of faith formation.

Our parish mission statement is clear that St. Peter's is "a learning community in which people pursue lifelong formation in the Faith." To this end, we are excited to offer these opportunities for the community to grow in friendship with God. We encourage all to take advantage of what our parish is offering.

Where can we find the answers to these questions and these desires? Until satisfied, we are left questioning, longing, and searching.

The Search video series guides viewers through an arc of seven episodes, examining the great big story of everything—life and death, sorrow and happiness, science and faith—as astrophysicists, psychologists, astronauts, neuroscientists, professors, athletes, artists, and the beauty of the cosmos all point to one big (and perhaps surprising) conclusion: that Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church have the best and most satisfying answers to every one of the questions and desires of the human heart.


