In response, we recently received an e-mail from the Bishop's Office stating that weekend Masses are not cancelled unless there is a State of Emergency in Massachusetts. This announcement of the cancellation of weekend Masses would also come from the Bishop, not individual pastors. Thus, unless there is a State of Emergency and official word from the Bishop, all 3 weekend Masses will be held as scheduled regardless of weather conditions. In storm situations, kindly use your best judgment concerning whether you should attend Mass. We are always happy to offer Masses at St. Peter's for those who are able to attend.
