

A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

Perhaps some of you have heard the Latin motto "Tempus Fugit, Memento Mori." Translated into English, this motto reads "Time Flies, Remember Death." At first glance, this motto may seem morbid but it teaches us a central truth of human life. This is that time moves quickly during life and death will come, eventually to all of us.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus teaches the people, citing the recent untimely deaths of unfortunate Galileans who were slaughtered by Romans and others who died unexpectedly in a tower collapse. After citing these examples, Jesus urges the people to "repent".

What is Jesus really saying? Jesus' examples present to us the fact that death is often the ultimate unexpected event in human life. We know not when it will happen to us but are sure that it will happen to us some day. In light of this certainty, Jesus urges us to turn away from sin and to turn towards God, in faith and prayer, today. We do not know that we will have a tomorrow in which to decide a different direction for our lives.

Being fallen creatures, we often put off things that we know we must do because they are difficult. What bad habits are we aware of that we know we need to stop? What good habits do we know we should start that would improve our lives? This Sunday's Gospel assures us that now is the time to stop sinful or harmful habits and begin holy and helpful ones.

During Lent, we prayerfully examine our lives with the help of the Holy Spirit. Coming to Mass each Sunday, or even daily, is the most important habit we can ever cultivate. Through this habit, we express to God our gratitude for His love and care for us and show Him our love in return. Jesus, truly present in The Holy Eucharist, is the greatest gift which Mass provides us. Our Eucharistic communion with the Lord gives us the grace and strength we need to live as faithful Christian disciples in today's challenging world.



A winner will be drawn every day in May and the winners will go back in the pool.




