A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Catholic Bible Dictionary tells us that the Greek word apostolos means "send" and that this implies that "an apostle is one who is sent." This Sunday, we celebrate the feast of St. Peter and Paul, Apostles. This feast seems especially relevant as we belong to St. Peter's Parish!

We know from Holy Scripture that when St. Peter made a confession of faith in Jesus at Caesarea Philippi, Jesus knew that God had chosen him to be the first Pope and declared that upon the rock of St. Peter's faith He would build His Church. Yet, throughout the gospels, we see that Peter was a human being like us all, prone to error, failure and sin. Still, Jesus never changed His mind about Peter. Despite his faults and his fallen humanity, Jesus still chose Him to be the Church's earthly shepherd after His death and Resurrection.

Also from Scripture, we know that St. Paul was formerly Saul, a zealous Jew who persecuted the Church prior to him meeting the Risen Christ on the Damascus Road. This meeting changed his life profoundly and made Paul an apostle. Though he had mistakenly persecuted Christians and was responsible for their deaths prior to his conversion, Jesus saw Paul's potential and entrusted to him a great mission of evangelization after he became Christian. Notably, both St. Peter and St. Paul were successful in their missions, becoming great saints and giving their lives in witness to Christ.

Through our Baptism, we are all *apostolos*, sent by God into the world to courageously spread the Good News of Jesus. May the example of Sts.

Peter and Paul inspire and direct us. Let us reflect upon the fact that despite their faults and failings, Jesus used these men to accomplish great things. May this fact give us hope in our attempts to live the Christian life.

We will be praying the Rosary also after Mass.


