

A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus sends out 72 disciples on mission, instructing them and preparing them for their important work. He tells them to pray that they may have more co-workers, to beware of evil's attempts to harm them, to trust in God's provision for them and to bring the people they encounter peace. He also teaches them the importance of being grateful for the hospitality they have received and to expect both some heartfelt welcomes and some rejection along the way. Jesus also reminds them that any success they have is because of the power and authority He has given them.

When we were Baptized, Jesus appointed us as His disciples and gave us the power of the Holy Spirit and Sacramental grace to assist us in our mission of bringing the Good News of Jesus to the world. How conscious are we of being disciples of Jesus? How much do we understand our Baptismal mission?

An important part of this Sunday's Gospel is Jesus' expectation that the disciples trust that He will provide for them as they go on mission. He conveys this when He instructs them to carry "no money bag, no sack, no sandals..." These instructions appear to contradict common sense and human reason. In the ancient world, travel involved significant dangers we rarely experience, including prolonged hunger and thirst, assault from brigands, exposure to cold and heat and much physical exertion. In order for the disciples to take Jesus' instructions seriously they needed both faith and trust.

We have faith in others and come to trust them as we grow in relationship with them over time. Time allows us to see that people are trustworthy and that their words are reliable. As our faith and trust in others grows, we can confidently invest ourselves more in the relationship. May our friendship with God grow deeper daily through prayer, grace, works of charity and active involvement in our parish community. As we grow deeper with Jesus, may we come to respond more fully our Baptismal call to be disciples of the Lord.

We will reflect upon the gospel for the upcoming Sunday, learn more about our Catholic Faith and pray for various intentions.


