
Propagation of The Faith Mission visiting Sister Chisom Azogu. on the weekend of September 20th & 21st at all Masses.

St. Peter's will warmly welcome Sister Chisom Asogu, of the Daughters of Mary Mother of Mercy as this year's Propagation of The Faith Mission visiting speaker.

Sister Chisom will be speaking to us about the missionary activities of her Religious community.

The Daughters of Mary Mother of Mercy Sisters have established orphanages. The sisters shelter, feed, clothe, educate, evangelize and protect these poor and most vulnerable orphans, motherless babies and some handicapped children and train them to be self-reliant. They also seek to have adequate and clean water for most of their facilities. By the grace of God and through generous donations, their community has been able to help many of their vulnerable population.

There will be a second collection next weekend September 20th & 21st to help support their mission in Nigeria .
