

### A Note From Father Michael

This Sunday's Gospel contains the Parable of The Persistent Widow which gives us some of Jesus' most important instructions on prayer. In the parable, a pesky widow keeps bothering an irreligious and unscrupulous judge for a just decision in a legal case. He puts her off, time and again, but eventually gives her a just decision due to her persistence. Through the parable, Jesus tells us that He wants us to persevere in prayer. This is because if an irreligious and unscrupulous judge can render a just judgment for a petitioner, so much more will God, who loves us and wants our best,

respond to our prayers in power.

It is often difficult to persevere in prayer because of the temptation to give up, as God may appear to not be responding to our prayer. Yet, Jesus implies in The Parable of The Persistent Widow that this is just a temptation. God only appears to not be responding to prayer. In reality, He is responding and is very aware of our needs. The Parable of The Persistent Widow suggests that God wants us to pray perseveringly so that this may expand within us a desire and capacity for prayer and give us a deeper need for relationship with God. Jesus is clear that our perseverance will yield for us God's loving response.

Suffering often can discourage us from prayer because we wonder how God can allow bad things to happen to us. Suffering can strain our friendship with God, even as we know that Jesus, God's Beloved Son, suffered greatly and died for our sake. Even Jesus and Mary, two sinless human beings, were not prevented by God from suffering! This truth reminds us that suffering, in all its forms, is part of the human condition.

Perhaps there is a need we have which we have been praying about a long time. Maybe we are frustrated praying for someone who seems closed to the gift of faith. Maybe we wonder whether God is hearing our prayer at all. Yet, Jesus' words to us are clear...keep praying and trusting that God is hearing and will respond.

# Join us on Tuesday, October 21st, 7:00pm in the parish hall for our first meeting. Everyone is welcome to join!


