


A Note From Father Michael

Next weekend, St. Peter's holds its annual Holiday Fair, a treasured tradition of community going back decades. The Fair is more than a fundraiser! At it, parishioners, families, friends and community members gather to celebrate the gift of St. Peter's Parish. The Fair showcases the dedication of our parish family, which is eager to share it's talents and gifts, for the benefit of our church. Hours of preparation have gone into making this year's Fair a success. Join us as we gather in friendship for this important annual event and enjoy food, wonderful crafts, raffles and much more.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus teaches us through the Parable of The Pharisee and The Publican. Our Lord is clear that it is the publican (tax collector) whom God finds acceptable in his prayer due to his humility, self-knowledge and honesty. These qualities allow the publican to need God who can save him. Jesus contrasts the publican's plea for God's mercy with the Pharisee's arrogant assertions that he is better than most human beings. The Pharisee sees himself as acceptable to God due to his Law-keeping. Sadly, however, God does not see the Pharisee this way! His pride has blinded him to himself and has prevented him from seeing his need for conversion.

As we listen to Jesus' teaching on our need for humility and self-knowledge before God, we also can see that the more we recognize our sins and failures the more we need Christ to save us from them. May our friendship with Christ deepen as we recognize our sinfulness and seek to receive God's grace.


