

# A Note From Father Michael

This Sunday, the Church observes All Soul's Day, a sacred liturgical celebration which commemorates all the faithful departed. All Soul's Day reminds us of our charitable responsibility to pray for our deceased loved ones and friends throughout the year. Our prayers for them, in the form of Masses, sacrifices and other intercessions, are our way of showing our beloved deceased love and respect.

Sadly, in the past several years, the number of Catholic funeral Masses being celebrated in our diocese has declined. There are probably many reasons for this but one clear is reason is that Catholic teaching on our need to pray for the dead has not been passed on to new generations.

Why do Catholics need to pray for the dead? From it's ancient beginning, the Church has faithfully recognized the existence of Purgatory, or purification after death for those who die in God's friendship but who are not yet perfectly ready to meet God. The existence of Purgatory is revealed in Sacred Scripture, though the word 'purgatory' does not appear in the Bible. Those in Purgatory cannot help themselves pass out of purification into Heaven. Rather, only the prayers of the living for those in Purgatory assist them in this process.

Offering Masses for the dead is a basic Catholic practice that shows our loving remembrance of those who have died and may concretely assist them if they are undergoing purification. Though we hope and pray that our loved ones are now fully with God, our prayers for them are always essential. Funeral Masses for deceased loved ones are important for them as well as for family and friends left behind. Everybody deserves funeral Masses and respectful remembrance, even those who are disadvantaged, without family or friends and those who have not practiced the Faith for many years.

May our reflection on the meaning of All Soul's Day remind us of our sacred responsibility to pray for the dead.
