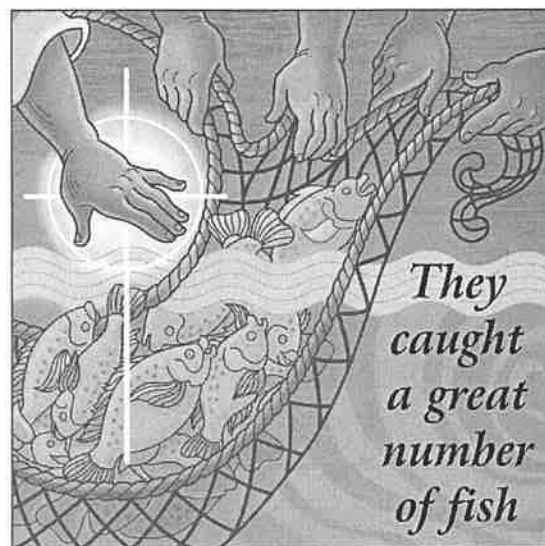

I am writing this column on Wednesday morning after driving to St. Agnes to celebrate Confessions and Mass and then driving to St. Ursula to write this so Maureen can get the bulletin printed before we have to leave for London tomorrow and attend the last session of the Workshop that pioneer Families are taking. With the weather warning of freezing rain I cancelled school confessions at Georges P. Vanier School and even though the weather was not as bad as I thought it might be - school buses were cancelled all the same. I will have to reschedule that session with the school children for their confessions. Father Don and I were assisted yesterday at St. Ursula School by Father John Juhl and Father Paul Duplessie and Father Ray Lawhead and Deacon Morgan (who spoke with non-baptized kids). Their assistance made the morning efficient for the school.

Valentine's Day is Thursday and it is a special day to tell the people in your life how they are loved and cherished. To all of my parishioners - Happy Valentine's Day and know you are loved and special.



#### NOW THAT'S A GOOD QUESTION

*Who is Saint Valentine and why do we celebrate the Day?*

Every February 14, across Canada and in other places around the world, candy, flowers and gifts are exchanged between loved ones, all in the name of St. Valentine. But who is this mysterious saint, and where did these traditions come from? Find out about the history of this centuries-old holiday, from ancient Roman rituals to the customs of Victorian England.

The history of Valentine's Day-and the story of its patron saint-is shrouded in mystery. We do know that February has long been celebrated as a month of romance, and that St. Valentine's Day, as we know it today, contains vestiges of both Christian and ancient Roman tradition. But who was Saint Valentine, and how did he become associated with this ancient rite?

The Catholic Church recognizes at least three different saints named Valentine or Valentinus, all of whom were martyred. One legend contends

that Valentine was a priest who served during the third century in Rome. When Emperor Claudius II decided that single men made better soldiers than those with wives and families, he outlawed marriage for young men. Valentine, realizing the injustice of the decree, defied Claudius and continued to perform marriages for young lovers in secret. When Valentine's actions were discovered, Claudius ordered that he be put to death.

Other stories suggest that Valentine may have been killed for attempting to help Christians escape harsh Roman prisons, where they were often beaten and tortured. According to one legend, an imprisoned Valentine actually sent the first "valentine" greeting himself after he fell in love with a young girl-possibly his jailor's daughter-who visited him during his confinement. Before his death, it is alleged that he wrote her a letter signed "From your Valentine," an expression that is still in use today. Although the truth behind the Valentine legends is murky, the stories all emphasize his appeal as a sympathetic, heroic and -most importantly - romantic figure. By the Middle Ages, perhaps thanks to this reputation, Valentine would become one of the most popular saints in England and France.

Valentine greetings were popular as far back as the Middle Ages, though written Valentines didn't begin to appear until after 1400.

In addition to Canada, Valentine's Day is celebrated in the United States, Mexico, the United Kingdom, France and Australia. In Great Britain, Valentine's Day began to be popularly celebrated around the 17th century. By the middle of the 18th, it was common for friends and lovers of all social classes to exchange small tokens of affection or handwritten notes, and by 1900 printed cards began to replace written letters due to improvements in printing technology. Ready-made cards were an easy way for people to express their emotions in a time when direct expression of one's feelings was discouraged. Cheaper postage rates also contributed to an increase in the popularity of sending Valentine's Day greetings.
