

Are we as Catholics to observe fasting during Lent?

Some people ask me about fasting during Lent. Is it still mandatory? It is strongly suggested that we make This means that we Fridays a day of abstinence. dedicate one day to sacrifice a week. This might mean going meatless or it might mean that you make a sacrifice that will mean something to you personally. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are the only two days when we as Catholics are to observe fasting and abstinence - which means going without meat and eating one main meal. The "abstinence from meat" binds those who are fourteen to sixty years of age. Parents and educators should introduce their children to the understanding and practice of penance gradually.




