**WORLD DAY OF THE POOR
Bishop Fabbro Launches the
Pope Francis Fund for the Poor**

Inspired by Jesus' preferential love for the poor, as well as by the example set by Pope Francis, Bishop Fabbro has chosen the Thirty-Third Sunday as World Day of the Poor. November 17, 2019 is the day the **Pope Francis Fund for the Poor** will be formally launched.

Thanks to the sale of surplus land adjacent to St. Peter's Seminary, Bishop Fabbro has committed one million dollars on behalf of all the faithful of the Diocese. The money will be invested in an endowment fund and proceeds earned will be given annually to agencies that directly serve the needs of people who are underprivileged. The agencies will be carefully qualified through a grant application process.

The endowment will be a continuing source of assistance for those in need, as well as a reminder that we are truly missionary disciples of Christ. Bishop Fabbro invites each of us to join in this collective effort by making a donation to the Pope Francis Fund for the Poor.

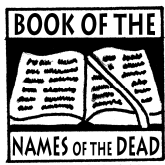

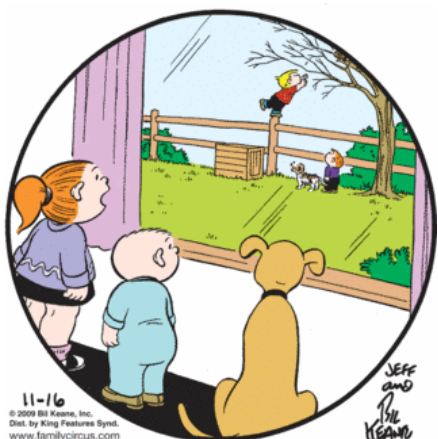

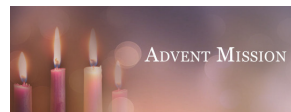
