## Readings for January 26

Isaiah 9: 1-4. 1 Corinthians 1: 10-13, 17-18.

Matthew 4: 12-23.

JANUARY 19, 2020 SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



We are back to the Ordinary Time of the Parter Church Calendar. During Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God offer

praise by celebrating the Paschal Mystery of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus.

On the first day of the week, the Lord's Day, God assembles the beloved people to hear the Word, to reflect upon it, to offer the living sacrifice of praise, and to eat and drink the banquet of the Lord. Then God sends them forth to proclaim this love by their words and actions.

Sunday is the original Christian feast day, following the tradition handed down from Apostolic times, for this was the day of the Lord's Resurrection. Today's Christian communities continue this tradition by celebrating every Sunday as the day of the risen Lord.

On Saturday, January 18th, we began to observe the Prayer for Christian Unity Week. It is celebrated around the world on January 18 - 25, which are also the dates recommended by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. However, there has also been a long-standing practice by a number of communities to celebrate the Week of Prayer on optional dates, in order to include two Saturdays.

This universal week of prayer encourages Christians of all denominations to meet, to participate in various liturgical and other community activities, and to pray together that all may be one, as Christ desires.

The importance of unity among Christians and the responsibility of the people of each parish to work for this unity should be emphasized throughout the week. All members of the parish should seek to have a deeper understanding of ecumenism.

This past Friday we celebrated the Memorial of St. Anthony, Abbot. Saint Anthony has a profound influence on the history of monasticism. Much of what we know about Anthony comes from a biography of him written by Saint Anthanasius. Anthony was born into a wealthy Christian family in Upper Egypt about 251. Both his parents died while he was a teenager; Anthony gave away his inheritance and became a hermit. After years of solitude, he emerged to gather ascetics who had followed him into a community. This was the beginning of Christian monasticism, with Anthony's understanding of monastic life soon taking root everywhere. In 311, Anthony went to Alexandria to encourage the Christians there who were being persecuted. In 355, he returned to Alexandria to help his close friend Bishop Anthanasius in the struggle against Arianism. Anthony died on January 17, 356 well known for his holiness, wisdom and asceticism.


