**PRESENTATION OF THE LORD**



It's February and we are lucky to have an extra day this month - yes, we are in a Leap Year. Well, that was true but he still aged like the rest of us. What this means for most of us is that repetitive feasts will be later - your birthday will be two days later than last year, Christmas will be on Friday this year. So enjoy this extra day this month.

I am going to be away for five days this week. I am going to visit Bishop McGrattan in Calgary. Hopefully the weather will not be bitterly cold. When I used to ski this would be a destination that I would look forward to. But now it is a chance to visit with Bishop Bill and enjoy his hospitality.

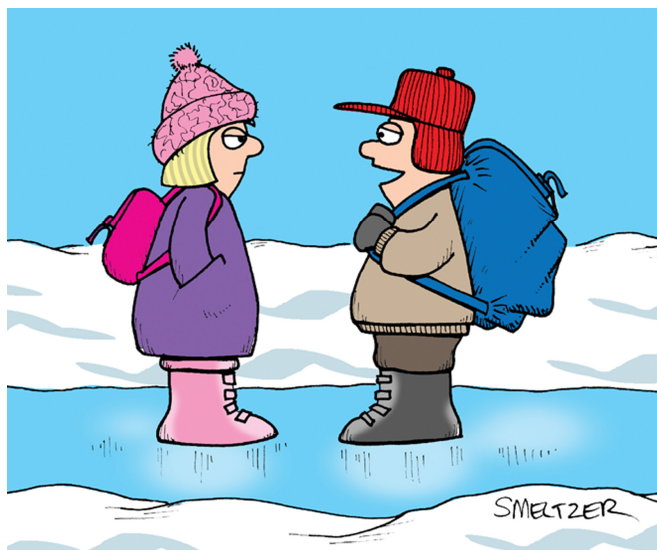
