Ash Wednesday is this Wednesday February 26th. We should find this time of Lent to be a renewal of our commitment to the Lord and as disciples of Jesus to find

ourselves rendering witness of our faith so that others will be drawn to Christ. In this prayer for Ash Wednesday allow yourself to humble yourself before the Lord and make this Lent the best ever in your life. "Yet even now, says the Lord, return to me with your whole heart.... rend your hearts..... and return to the Lord, your God." (Joel 2:12-13)

Lord, I come to Lent once again with the same frame of mind I've had in previous years. Lent is not a pleasant experience for me; I find it so hard to look forward to. That is not because of any form of penance I undertake or any manner of discipline it demands of me, but because everything is so much the same from year to year. And I always seem to be the same when it is over. Seemingly so much effort and so little to show for it.

This year, I once again set out to seek you and to find you, but I want to do more this Lent, to seek you and find you in a more lasting and meaningful way. Forgive me, Lord, I don't want to slip back in to my uncaring, habit-ridden ways as soon as Easter passes. I wish with all my being to seek you in a new way, with new awareness, with new determination,

yes, with new imagination. You are the ultimate meaning of Lent. The season makes little sense without you and your resurrection. Help me, then to put aside the Lents of the past, and to enter into the present season full of love in seeking you and joy in finding you. May your mind, your presence, your example, your Spirit, touch me as never before so that I may, day after unwilling day, seek you wherever you may be found; in any circumstance, at any time, in any person, even in myself.

Make the effort to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation and if possible attend daily Mass during the week. There are common prayers of the Stations of the Cross on Friday evenings at St. Agnes at 7 pm. Give the example of being intentional disciples of Jesus and deepen your own awareness of the Lord's presence in your life and the promise of eternal life in you. Make this the best Lent ever.


PRE-AUTHORIZED DEBIT (PAD)


