November 8, 2020 THIRTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Deacon's Pen

Remembrance Day is almost upon us. Like all of you, I know why we celebrate it on November 11th; the signing of the armistice to end World War 1.

Do you think it may be a coincidence that November is also the month we remember, in a special way, those who have died? We also pray for them in a special way. November 2^{nd} is the feast of 'All Souls', a day when we can pray for and obtain an indulgence for those who have died but have not yet entered heaven.

The Catholic Church teaches that not everyone who dies in God's grace is immediately ready for the Beatific Vision, that is, the direct experience of God and His perfect nature in heaven. So they must be purified of "lesser faults," and the temporal punishment due to sin in a place or state of purification. The Catholic teaching on Purgatory essentially requires belief in two realities:

- 1. That there will be a purification of believers prior to entering Heaven.
- 2. That the prayers and Masses of the faithful in some way benefit those in the state of purification.

As on November 11th, we remember the men and women who died trying to ensure our freedom, let us also remember and pray for those who are willing to take risks to ensure our health, safety and freedom every day: Firefighters, Police, Paramedics, Nurses, Doctors and the list goes on. I have included a short story that may inspire us to also remember that our help is needed.

A man walking through the forest saw a fox that had lost its legs and wondered how it lived. Then he saw a tiger come in with game in its mouth. The tiger had its fill and left the rest of the meat for the fox.

The next day God fed the fox by means of the same tiger. The man began to wonder at Gods greatness and said to himself, "I too shall just rest in a corner with full trust in the Lord and he will provide me with all I need."

He did this for many days but nothing happened, and he was almost at deaths door when he heard a voice say, "O you who are in the path of error, open your eyes to the truth! Follow the example of the tiger and stop imitating the disabled fox."

On the street I saw a naked child, hungry and shivering in the cold. I became angry and said to God, "Why do you permit this? Why don't you do something?"

For a while God said nothing. That night he replied, quite suddenly, "I certainly did do something. I made you".

Notes from Rodger

I wish to thank you for your financial support to date. There is a variety of ways to donate to the parish of choice.

Clarification of a few items regarding the process at the Parish office.

Currently there is a core group of volunteers that open, count and record the weekend collections by parish. The current volunteers have been doing it for some time. We thank them for their time.

Another preferred method for simplicity is EFT (electronic fund transfer). It goes seamlessly from your account to the parish of your designation.

Pre Authorized Debit (PAD) is a form available to step up the process. This also becomes a seamless repetitive method of payment.

Cash is also welcome and is manual in the counting process.

Cheques are in the same category as cash in terms of handling and process of recording.

It is important to realize that the Parish name has to be on the cheque. Bank of Montreal is not able to recognize "Chatham Catholic Family of Parishes" as a payee and know which parish account it goes in as each parish still has individual bank accounts.

Examples of acceptable donations in one cheque are: St. Vincent de Paul, Regular donation, Capital, Spirit and Life Centre, Easter, Christmas etc. Examples of donations that should be made out in a separate cheque are: Catholic Women's League and Knights of Columbus as they collect their own dues. They cannot be paid to individual parishes.

Please note also:

Payments for Mass stipends should not be submitted in offertory envelopes. These are not donations. These need to be put in a separate envelope clearly marked as payment for a mass intention so they are not deposited as offertory. Thank you!
