

However, the most important thing is what we hold deep in our hearts! When we participate in the celebration of the Mass (or any other celebration or service) with anger, resentment, uncleanness, evil intentions, or other inappropriate and unloving thoughts / desires in our hearts, as Jesus tells us, we worship Him in vain!

We all need to examine what is in our hearts <u>every day!</u> This is typically done through an Examination of Conscience. When we find <u>anything</u> other than genuine faith, hope, love, and compassion in our hearts, it is <u>imperative</u> that we actively seek our Lord's forgiveness. It is also very important that we regularly attend to the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Then we need to seek quality Spiritual Direction to lead us and guide us along the path of becoming faith filled Christians who hold, deep in our hearts, genuine faith, hope, love, and compassion!

If you would like to learn how to conduct a quality Examination of Conscience every day, or if you have questions about quality Spiritual Direction, contact any member of the Pastoral Team. We will be pleased to assist you. If you need to attend the Sacrament of Reconciliation to receive our Lord's Mercy, His forgiveness and reconciliation, Confessions take place on Saturdays at Blessed Sacrament Church from 9 - 10 am. Our Priests will be pleased to celebrate this wonderful sacrament with you!
