

FAMILY UPDATE from Fr. John

DIOCESE OF LONDON VACCINATION POLICY



On October 18, 2021, Bishop Fabbro issued a letter along with the Diocese of London Vaccination Policy for priests, deacons, lay ecclesial ministers and volunteers. Here DIOCESE OF are some important points of the policy

LONDON that I would like to emphasize:

- This vaccination policy is a temporary but necessary measure to keep staff and parishioners safe during this global crisis—we all have a responsibility for the common good—not only protecting ourselves but others as Pope Francis has said, "Being vaccinated with vaccines authorized by the competent authorities is an act of love...each one of us can make his or her own small gesture of love..."
- All bishops, priests, deacons, lay ecclesial ministers and parish staff must provide proof of full vaccination to their respective supervisors no later than 45 days from the promulgation of the policy. This also includes all clergy and lay presenters who come from outside the diocese for the purpose of doing ministry in the Diocese of London.
- Any visitors to diocesan, parish, and cemetery offices and any independent contractors are also subject to the policy---visitors or contractors in these buildings for less than 15 minutes are not required to provide proof of vaccination but must follow all other safety protocols
- All volunteers currently serving in our family of parishes (Mass Hosts, Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors, Video Team, Money Counters, Musicians/ Cantors) must provide proof of vaccination, by printing a Certificate of Vaccination or an official receipt of your second dose, to the parish office in a sealed envelope addressed to Fr. John Jasica. Fr. John will be the only one who will verify compliance with the policy and securely store the documentation.
- As a reminder—this policy does not apply for our liturgical celebrations (Masses, Weddings, Funerals, Confessions) so you do not need to provide proof of vaccination but must comply with current safety policies that includes wearing a mask.

LIVE-STREAMING OF MASSES & CELEBRATIONS



Starting this Sunday (October 24, 2021), the St. Joseph 8 AM Mass will be livestreamed each week via the Chatham Catholic Family of Parishes YouTube channel. Our first official stream was on Thanksgiving Monday. We will continue to

stream the 9 AM Mass from Blessed Sacrament but are also looking to start streaming the Saturday night Mass as well to allow as many people to join us online as possible.

With the opportunity to stream Masses and other celebrations (funerals, weddings & other devotions) we need more volunteers. No experience is required—we will train you and support you in this new Video Team ministry. If you are interested please email me at jjasica@dol.ca.

DEACON'S PEN

Our Gospel this weekend provides a wonderful example of genuine faith and trust in Jesus combined with the courage to call upon Jesus for help!

Bartimaeus had no reason to believe that Jesus could or would help him. His life experience was one of begging and being ignored and ridiculed. His contemporaries believed that either he or his parents (or both) had sinned, and that is why he had been afflicted with blindness. For that reason, they had no difficulty ignoring or ridiculing him. That was life as he knew it.

However, something told Bartimaeus that this itinerant preacher was somehow different - that He could and would help him. Even as Bartimaeus was calling out to Jesus, the people were sternly ordering him to be quiet and to not bother or trouble the Teacher. Instead, Bartimaeus cried out even more loudly to Jesus. His instinct was correct. Jesus did help him in a foundational way - He gave Bartimaeus his sight, and fundamentally changed his life. Bartimaeus, in response, began to follow Jesus, becoming one of His disciples.

Dr. Marcellino D'Ambrosio, in his weekly reflection on the Sunday Readings, points out that every Sunday we are confronted with the very real presence of the same One who healed blind Bartimaeus.

In the Eucharist, Christ - Body, Blood, Soul, & Divinity is made truly present and available to us! So why do so many of us go to Mass again and again and walk out the door much the same as we walked in? Why is there so little healing, so little growth in holiness? Maybe it is because we lack the outrageous faith of Bartimaeus.

This begs the question - do we have the genuine faith, the genuine trust, and the genuine courage to turn to Jesus with our whole hearts and follow Him unreservedly? JESUS, I TRUST IN YOU!
