


SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION - FORMING FAITHFUL DISCIPLES

Dear parents and guardians of our First Reconciliation & First Communion candidates,

INVOLVING PARENTS MORE & SHARING OUR FAITH EXPERIENCE – A GREAT GIFT FOR ALL!!

I am writing this letter to you as the school year comes to a close, letting you know that we as a family of parishes (the five Catholic churches in Chatham) are getting ready for sacramental preparation now. This fall we are making a major shift in our sacramental preparation that we hope will strengthen the gift of your faith and build up our family of parishes sharing and living the Good News. Here are some things you need to know:





- 2. All our sacramental preparation programs will use a small faith sharing group model that encourages everyone to share their experience of faith together, supporting one another.
- 3. Since the primary faith educators of children are their parents, we as a parish, support parents in forming these young disciples. This will require the attendance and participation of at least one of the candidate's parents or grandparents at each of the preparation sessions.
- 4. The three basic foundations of our sacramental preparation will focus on **sharing one's own faith experience** (seeing how faith connects with real life), building a greater sense of **community** and **catechesis** (understanding the teachings of faith).

This is a significant change from past years, but it is one that we hope will have a strong, positive impact on candidates, families, and the parish. We are taking a more intentional approach supporting not only the candidate, but parents, grandparents, and family members together hoping to further integrate everyone into the life of Christ through the family of parishes.

I know that change can cause some frustration and difficulty, but we all realize that there needs to be a better and more impactful way to prepare our candidates and their families for the sacraments. With the change in focus and method, we are also changing the schedule.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION - A FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE

I understand the busy lives families lead today, especially in our post-pandemic world. I really think that they are too busy!!! Children are involved in so many amazing programs, sports, and activities. The Chatham Catholic Family of Parishes wants to be as flexible as possible making things manageable for families that are constantly on the go. With this in mind, we are offering First Reconciliation & First Communion preparation twice in the upcoming year. Families will be able to choose the cycle that best meets their schedule. This change will also mean the opportunity to celebrate the sacraments throughout the year when the candidates are ready and when families can truly rejoice together.

The two cycles of preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion will take place Saturday afternoons prior to the 5:00 PM Mass at the Blessed Sacrament Church Hall (4:00 to 5:00 pm) and on Sundays after the 9:00 AM Mass at the Blessed Sacrament Church Hall (10:15 to 11:15 am). Each sacrament will have 4 weekends of mandatory preparation. Families will be able to choose from the Saturday afternoon or Sunday morning gatherings each of those weekends. With this schedule, families will be able to attend Mass together as part of the preparation for the sacrament. There will also be one MAKE-UP Saturday morning for each round just in case to once again be as flexible and adaptable to the needs and schedules of busy families.

Step #4 – You will receive a confirmation email to let you know that your child has been registered. Further information will be sent to you in preparation for the parent meeting and the sessions in the fall.

DEACON'S PEN

This Sunday's Gospel can be confusing. Throughout the four Gospels and the New Testament Letters we are told that Jesus came to change our minds about through His Passion, God, and, Death, Resurrection, to throw open the Gates of Heaven for all who genuinely believe and place all their trust in Him!

Now, we read Jesus saying that He came to "bring fire to the earth", and to bring "division". How do we make sense of this? I believe that the answer lies in the condition of so many human hearts, and in the immense often destructive effect of the unchecked human ego. Either we actively choose to accept and embrace Jesus as our Lord and Saviour, or we choose to go our own way, hoping for the best. Fr. Larry Richards, a Catholic Priest in Erie Pennsylvania is often heard to say that the theme song in Hell is "I did it my way".

To actively choose to accept Jesus as our Lord and Saviour means that we actively choose to honour and obey the Ten Commandments, and that we actively choose to build a genuine love relationship with Jesus! Then, we actively choose to spend quality time, every day, reading and praying over the Sacred Scriptures, and in Contemplative Prayer, sitting quietly listening to what the Holy Spirit is saying to Finally, this means actively choosing to love others as ourselves. The simplest way to demonstrate our genuine love for others is by regularly performing at least some of the Fourteen Charitable Works of Mercy that are recommended by the Church.

All of this, if followed faithfully will build genuine love and humility in our hearts. This does bring fire to the earth! 
