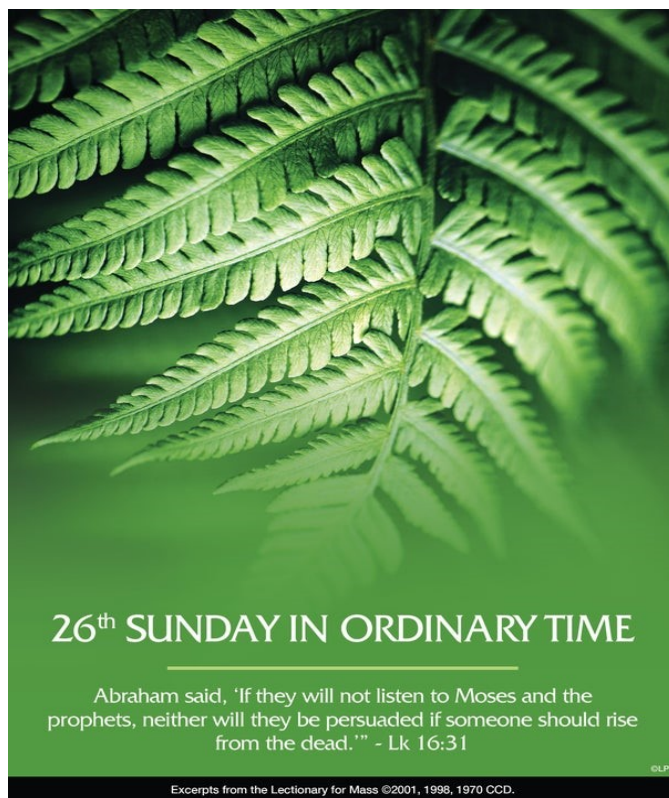

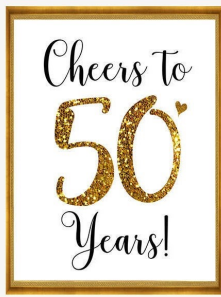

Lynda is not retiring!! She continues to serve all of us—hopefully for years to come!! May the Lord continue to bless her and her family with peace and good health always.

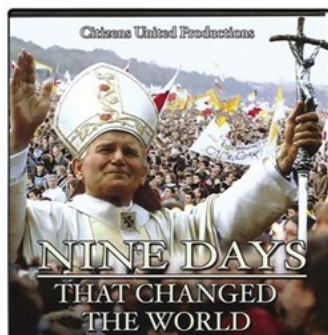
## FAITH FILM SERIES

The Pope sparked a revolution of conscience in the Polish people that led to the success of Solidarity's free-trade union movement, and ultimately the fall of the Berlin Wall and collapse of the Soviet Union (94 minutes)

## CK4UKRAINE UPDATE

Meet the Pieshkins!



They are a family of five, mom, dad, and their children: two boys age 8 and 6 and a girl age 4. Dmytro, the father worked as a physical education teacher at a Christian school in Ukraine.

The Pieshkins arrived on Wednesday, September 14. They are now settling into their home and must quarantine for two weeks.

Our Family of Parishes has helped with their arrival by providing the fresh food and some meats to help their settling in and time of quarantine.

**HOW CAN YOU SUPPORT THEM?** The CK4Ukraine team (which we are a part of) is asking for donations of grocery store gift cards to help support the family as they start their new journey in a new country, learn our language, and seek employment, drivers licenses etc.

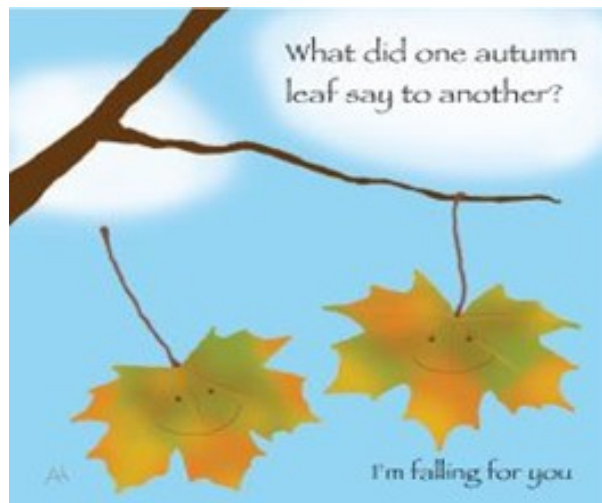

**Child:** What is one thing you and your family could do this week to help those who are poor or sick?

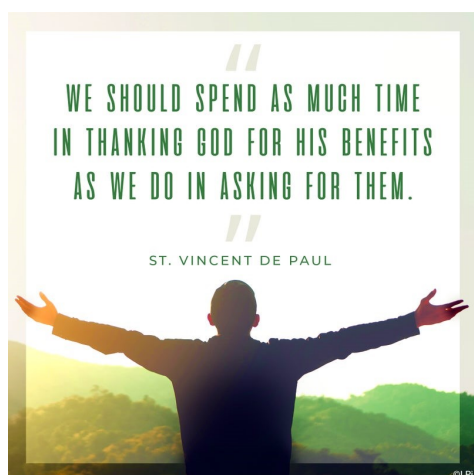


### **WE NEED YOUR HELP!**
