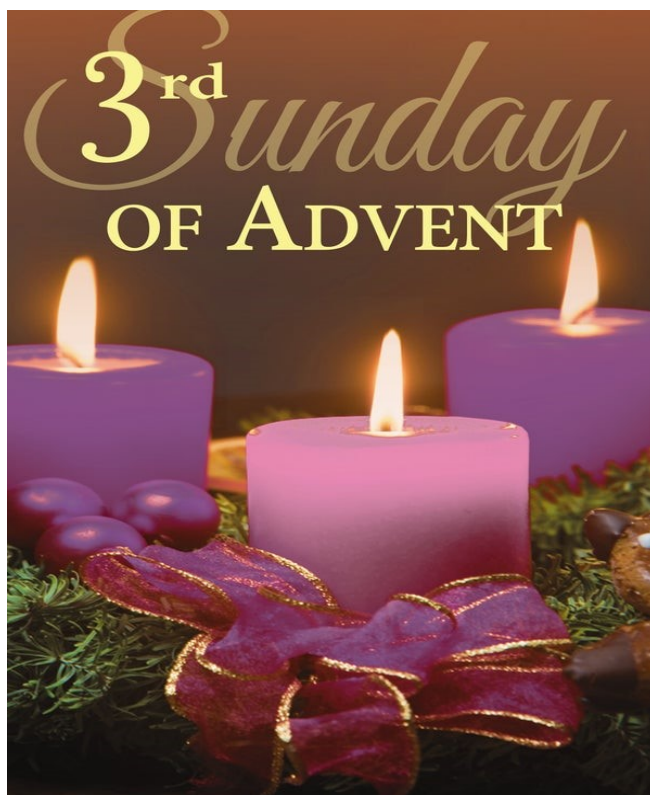

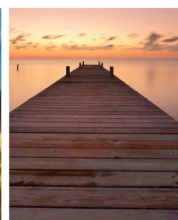
ARE YOU READY FOR CHRISTMAS?

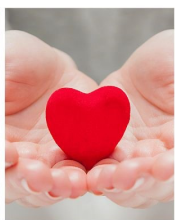

ADVENT HOPE ALIVE IN OUR MIDST

Everyone registered in the family of parishes should be receiving a Christmas letter and envelope from me inviting everyone to attend our many liturgical celebrations while also supporting us financially.

Our faith community is embarking on a new path of ministry and outreach rooted in forming parishioners as faithful disciples who are equipped, inspired, supported and courageous to bring the love, hope, joy and peace of Jesus to our world today. The transformation is already slowly happening as we recover from the pandemic and seek to be a light of hope in a new and more powerful way in Chatham and beyond. This can only happen with the involvement and financial support of all the faithful.

Over the next several months, we as a family of parishes will pray, reflect and discern how best we embrace this new pastoral plan. We know that changes are long overdue and the current set up of our family is not sustainable. We are spending too much time trying to maintain buildings and sustain a past that is no longer present while not spending enough time on ministry and outreach. For us to truly live out the Gospel most effectively—we will require significant change, not in an attempt to survive but to thrive.

As a family staff we are already seeing signs of hope, unity and the effects of change. We are rebuilding relationships, making connections and strengthening the sense of ONE community with ONE mission as disciples. We are reaching out to families through our sacramental preparation programs, family movie nights, Advent Family Night & Hayride, St. Nicholas Celebration, Halloween Family event and our Catholic schools.

In order for us to continue our transformation and be a bright shining light of Christ in our world, we will need many more volunteers to help us create an atmosphere of hospitality, welcome and family. This includes all the ministries for our weekend Masses, family & youth ministry—in addition to our amazing outreach that we offer and want to grow, making sure that those in most need are cared for first.

The needs are great for us to move forward but this can only happen if all of us, first and above all, allow Christ to dwell in our hearts and become the source of why we serve. Long term investment through volunteering and providing financial resources will help us bring the Christmas joy of salvation to so many in our city. Please prayerfully consider how you can get involved and financially support the mission work we are all doing as a Christmas gift to our Lord, and to those in our family of parishes.

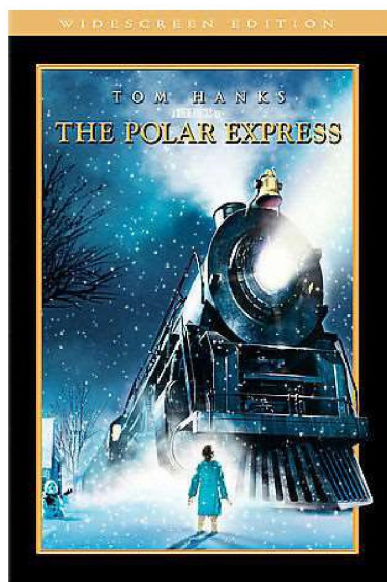

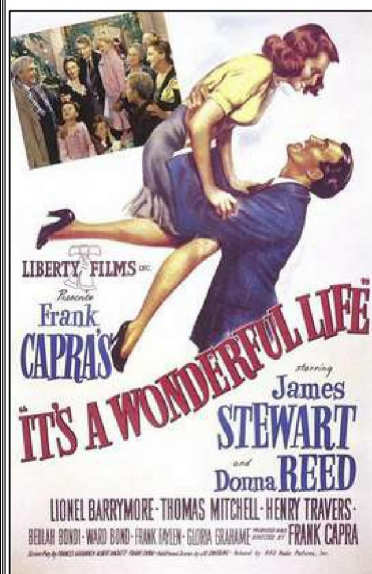

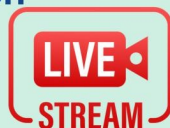
