# FAMILY UPDATES

## THE ROAD TO EMMAUS — A TIME OF MISSION



Happy Easter everyone!! We continue the Easter season celebrating and rejoicing in the resurrection and the call to mission in our lives as followers of Jesus. This weekend we hear the powerful gospel story of the Road to Emmaus. I cannot help but think and pray how this story is vital for us during our time of discernment for our family of parishes called **IGNITE THE MISSION**. This beautiful encounter along the road with Christ changes everything for these two sad disciples who thought they had lost their Lord and friend. They thought they had lost hope!!

### **(1) SHARING THE STORY OF SALVATION**

When Jesus walks along with the two disciples along the road, they do not recognize him. They end up discussing the events of recent days when Jesus was betrayed, falsely accused and crucified. They are sad and forget the story of salvation. Jesus breaks open the scriptures for the two disciples and reminds them of all that they were taught—that God's love is everlasting and that Jesus had to die but also in three days would rise again. The disciples begin to make the connections and begin to be filled with some sense of hope.

We too in our family of parishes have to remind ourselves of the story of salvation. To remember what Christ has taught us and what he calls us to as missionaries in our world today. We must continue the story of God's love and allow the resurrection to be seen not just by Catholics, but by everyone in the city of Chatham through our compassion, love and service. The sharing sessions, feedback forms and continued dialogue together allows Christ to guide us moving forward to share the Good News.

### **(2) BREAKING OF THE BREAD TO MISSION**

The disciples recognize Jesus at the table during the breaking of the bread. This is a clear reference to the Last Supper and our celebration of Mass. As we gather around the table, Jesus comes into our midst to feed, heal and strengthen us with the final and eternal covenant—His body and blood. This transforms us and fills us with the Holy Spirit.

The disciples rejoice and run back to Jerusalem telling everyone that Jesus is alive. We too must leave the table sharing the resurrection in service to those who are in need, alone or forgotten. We have to determine how effectively we can do this today. How can we translate this truth in this culture?

It has been tradition in many parishes to celebrate and remember loved ones who have died over the past year. Often it takes place around the celebrations of All Saints and All Souls Day. Of course, the pandemic changed all of that for us. Thankfully, things are now slowly settling into a new normal for all of us.

We will be celebrating a Memorial Mass at **St. Joseph Church on Sunday May 28, 2023—2PM**—as we end the Easter season with the Solemnity of Pentecost.
