MEMORIAL MASS-SUNDAY MAY 28, 2023



It has been tradition in many parishes to celebrate and remember loved ones who have died over the past year. Often it takes place around the celebrations of All Saints and All Souls Day. Of course, the pandemic changed all of that for us. Thankfully, things are now slowly settling into a new normal for all of us.

We will be celebrating a Memorial Mass at St. Joseph Church on Sunday May 28, 2023—2PM—as we end the Easter season with the Solemnity of Pentecost. The Easter season is always a powerful time to rejoice in the gift of eternal life given to us by Christ. This celebration is open to everyone!! We will also be hosting a reception following the Mass at the Spirit & Life Centre.

We will be specifically inviting families who have lost loved ones and whose funerals were celebrated in our family of parishes over the last couple of years as a special way to offer continued comfort and support.

We are also asking parishioners to send in names of loved ones (via an online form at www.chathamcatholic.ca or by calling the parish office) who have died during the pandemic so that they can also be remembered at this special celebration. We ask that all names be submitted by Monday May 22, 2023 so that a special program can be produced for the Mass.

CELEBRATING 100 YEARS OF BLESSED SACRAMENT CHURCH



Blessed Sacrament Parish in Chatham was established on October 30, 1921. Its pastor, Fr. Ralph Hubert Dignan (1921 -1929), offered the parish's first Mass in "The Pines" chapel.

The present rectory was purchased from the Malcolmson estate, originally the home of Hugh Malcomson, a former mayor of Chatham and owner of The New York House on King Street West. The firm of Benjamin Blonde built the present church with a medieval French gothic style façade along with a beautiful rose window built by master carpenter David Hamon.

On the morning of February 4, 1923, Blessed Sacrament Church was officially opened and blessed

by Bishop Fallon, and in the evening he celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation there for the first time.

We as a family of parishes would like to mark this 100th anniversary with a special weekend of celebration on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi — June 10-11, 2023. There will be two major events to mark this anniversary.

(1) MASS & DINNER WITH BISHOP FABBRO

Bishop Fabbro will celebrate Mass on <u>Saturday</u> <u>June 10, 2023 at 5 PM</u> marking the 100th anniversary followed by a pasta dinner in the parish hall immediately following. Tickets for the dinner are on sale beginning this weekend at the back of the church following the Blessed Sacrament Masses or anytime during the week or at the parish offices at St. Agnes Church.


Tickets for the dinner are \$10/per person with children under 10 free. There is limited seating so please purchase your tickets as soon as you can.


BABY BOTTLE BOOMERANG
