## CELEBRATING 100 YEARS OF BLESSED SACRAMENT CHURCH



Blessed Sacrament Parish in Chatham was established on October 30, 1921. Its pastor, Fr. Ralph Hubert Dignan (1921-1929), offered the parish's first Mass in "The Pines" chapel.

The present rectory was purchased from the Malcolmson estate, originally the home of Hugh Malcomson, a former mayor of Chatham and owner of The New York House on King Street West. The firm of Benjamin Blonde built the present church with a medieval French gothic style façade along with a beautiful rose window built by master carpenter David Hamon.

On the morning of February 4, 1923, Blessed Sacrament Church was officially opened and blessed by Bishop Fallon, and in the evening he celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation there for the first time.

We as a family of parishes would like to mark this 100th anniversary with a special weekend of celebration on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi — June 10-11, 2023. There will be two major events to mark this anniversary.

#### (1) MASS & DINNER WITH BISHOP FABBRO

Bishop Fabbro will celebrate Mass on <u>Saturday</u> <u>June 10</u>, <u>2023 at 5 PM</u> marking the 100th anniversary followed by a pasta dinner in the parish hall immediately following. Tickets for the dinner are on sale beginning this weekend at the back of the church following the Blessed Sacrament Masses or anytime during the week or at the parish offices at St. Agnes Church.

Tickets for the dinner are \$10/per person with children under 10 free. There is limited seating so please purchase your tickets as soon as you can.


#### FAITH FILM SERIES—NO GREATER LOVE

## **Gospel Meditation Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture**

My dad was adopted as a baby. It's a big part of my family's story. His birth mother placed him in a Catholic orphanage not long after birth. A young couple longing for a baby strolled among the bassinets. My father, then only a few months old, looked at the husband and smiled. The man said, "That's my son." They took him home and the family grew. This moment of adoption was a wonderful truth they celebrated even when my dad was a young boy. They told him, "You're even more special than the other children, because we chose you to be our son." My dad's eyes well up with tears of gratitude whenever he tells the story, even eighty-three years later.

What is your story? Do we think or act like unwanted orphans? Who do we believe ourselves to be? As we continue to ponder Jesus' resurrection, we hear him say to us this Sunday, "I will not leave you orphans." God doesn't leave us alone like spiritual orphans. The power that raised Jesus from the dead is the Holy Spirit, who is also called the Spirit of Adoption. He chooses us to be His children, to share God's life forever. He gives us a future filled with hope.

We are not orphans anymore! This Easter, that's the story we should share with others. It's the true story we are living right now.
