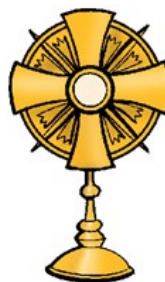

BISHOP FABBRO VISITS OUR FAMILY

(1) BLESSED SACRAMENT CELEBRATES 100 YEARS!

This weekend Bishop Fabbro makes a special pastoral visit to the Chatham Catholic Family of Parishes. His visit includes a special Mass at Blessed Sacrament Church marking the 100th anniversary of its official opening on February 4, 1923. Following the Mass the bishop will join nearly 200 others at a pasta dinner in the Blessed Sacrament hall. We are truly blessed to have rich histories of faith from each of our five churches in our family. Marking significant milestones is a way for us to honour the past while also looking towards the future.

(2) BISHOP MEETS WITH THE FAMILY STAFF

On Saturday morning Bishop Fabbro is spending time with the family staff answering their questions/concerns (which have been forwarded in advance) and getting a better understanding of the joys and challenges of serving, working and ministering in a family of parishes. The Chatham Catholic Family of Parishes is one of two pioneer families that have been in existence the longest—this gives the bishop a better understanding of how things have progressed through the years and to seek pieces of wisdom that will help him and diocesan leadership support all the families.

This will also be a chance for Bishop Fabbro to offer support and his perspective on how things will move forward as we work together following God's path to become missionary disciples seeking to transform the world.

(3) BISHOP MEETS WITH PASTORAL COUNCIL & FINANCE COMMITTEE

Bishop Fabbro is also meeting with the Family Pastoral Council and Finance Committee in a joint session to discuss our IGNITE THE MISSION discernment journey. Both the Pastoral Council and Finance Committee have questions (which they forwarded in advance) for the bishop seeking clarifications and a better understanding of how our family and all the families of parishes should move forward.

The dialogue and conversation will include elements of the **FEEDBACK FORMS GENERAL SUMMARY** (which I personally delivered to Bishop Fabbro), **IGNITE THE**

MISSION: APOSTLES FOR A NEW ERA, 2021 & 2022 FINANCIAL REVIEW reports, and the **PASTORAL PLAN "GAME PLAN"** developed by staff and the Pastoral Council in the last couple of years.

In addition to listening and discussing our circumstances as a family of parishes, the Pastoral Council and Finance Committee will be able to understand better Bishop Fabbro's vision and expectations for families as they seek to adapt and change to meet the needs of the world today. We are not the only family of parishes facing financial hardships and the need for closures in order to support ministries, programs and outreach that are relevant for society today.

There are certain elements of our transformation that are dependent on Bishop Fabbro's support and direction. We need to remember that we are not alone in this change as other families in the diocese are going through similar circumstances. This means that there are certain policies that are being developed so that there can be consistency and appropriate support throughout the diocese.

PIECES ARE COMING TOGETHER

I had the opportunity about a week and a half ago to meet with Bishop Fabbro personally for a substantial time sharing the joys, challenges, frustrations and fears of change for our family of parishes. The bishop expressed his support of our IGNITE THE MISSION discernment journey and is very happy to see a very clear pastoral plan for the future—developing faithful disciples who reach out to all. (our "GAME PLAN")

Bishop Fabbro was very interested in hearing the responses of the faithful through our sharing sessions and feedback forms. He knows that as we move forward, we will all need to work together embracing our mission to proclaim the Gospel, which is very different today than it was even twenty years ago. The bishop understands the challenges we all face in the world today, the economic difficulties in our personal lives and the struggles we face in our parishes. Consultation with the bishop is another major piece in the puzzle to discern God's will for us.

ROOTED IN PRAYER—SEEKING GOD'S GRACE

Our journey forward will only succeed through prayer. Stay tuned for information about our IGNITE THE MISSION PRAYER RELAY that will take place this summer in our five churches praying for God's will and open hearts to embrace the journey ahead.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION - FORMING FAITHFUL DISCIPLES

Dear parents and guardians of our First Reconciliation & First Communion candidates,

INVOLVING PARENTS MORE & SHARING OUR FAITH EXPERIENCE – A TRUE GIFT!

I am writing this letter to you as the school year comes to a close, letting you know that we as a family of parishes (the five Catholic churches in Chatham) are getting ready for sacramental preparation now. Last fall we made a major shift in our sacramental preparation that is strengthening the gift of your faith and build up our family of parishes sharing and living the Good News. Here are some things you need to know:



1. All ministries and programs in our faith community, especially sacramental preparation, will focus on **forming disciples** who will follow Christ every day **reaching out to all**.
2. All our sacramental preparation programs will use a small faith sharing group model that encourages everyone to share their experience of faith together, supporting one another.
3. Since the primary faith educators of children are their parents, we as a parish, support parents in forming these young disciples. **This will require the attendance and participation of at least one of the candidate's parents or grandparents at each of the preparation sessions.**
4. The three basic foundations of our sacramental preparation will focus on **sharing one's own faith experience** (seeing how faith connects with real life), building a greater sense of **community** and **catechesis** (understanding the teachings of faith).

This is a significant change from past years, but it is one that we hope will have a strong, positive impact on candidates, families, and the parish. We are taking a more intentional approach supporting not only the candidate, but parents, grandparents, and family members together hoping to further integrate everyone into the life of Christ through the family of parishes.

I know that change can cause some difficulty, but we realize that there needs to be a more impactful way to prepare our candidates and their families for the sacraments. With the change in focus and method, we are also changing the schedule.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION – A FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE

I understand the busy lives families lead today, especially in our post-pandemic world. Children are involved in so many amazing programs, sports, and activities. The Chatham Catholic Family of Parishes wants to be as flexible as possible making things manageable for families that are constantly on the go. With this in mind, we are offering First Reconciliation & First Communion preparation twice in the upcoming year. Families will be able to choose the cycle that best meets their schedule. This change will also mean the opportunity to celebrate the sacraments throughout the year when the candidates are ready and when families can truly rejoice together.

The two cycles of preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion will take place Saturday afternoons prior to the 5:00 PM Mass at the Blessed Sacrament Church Hall (4:00 to 5:00 pm) OR on Sundays after the 9:00 AM Mass at the Blessed Sacrament Church Hall (10:15 to 11:15 am). Each sacrament will have 4 weekends of mandatory preparation. Families will be able to choose from the Saturday

afternoon or Sunday morning gatherings each weekend of preparation. With this schedule, families will be able to attend Mass together as part of the preparation for the sacrament.

HOW DO I REGISTER MY CHILD FOR FIRST RECONCILIATION & FIRST COMMUNION?

Step #1 – Go to the family of parishes website at www.chathamcatholic.ca and look for the FIRST RECONCILIATION/FIRST COMMUNION REGISTRATION link. (Registrations are now open)

Step #2 – Fill out the online registration form by answering all the questions and all the contact information required. You will be asked which cycles of preparation for each sacrament you will attend. You can prepare in whichever order is easier for you and your family.

Step #3 - We ask for a donation of \$40 to help with materials and other communication expenses.

- in person at the family of parishes office (St. Agnes Church—52 Croydon St.)
- at the Parent Information Sessions or at any of the preparation meetings on the weekends

Step #4 – You will receive a confirmation email to let you know that your child has been registered. Further information will be sent to you in preparation for the parent meeting and the sessions in the fall.
