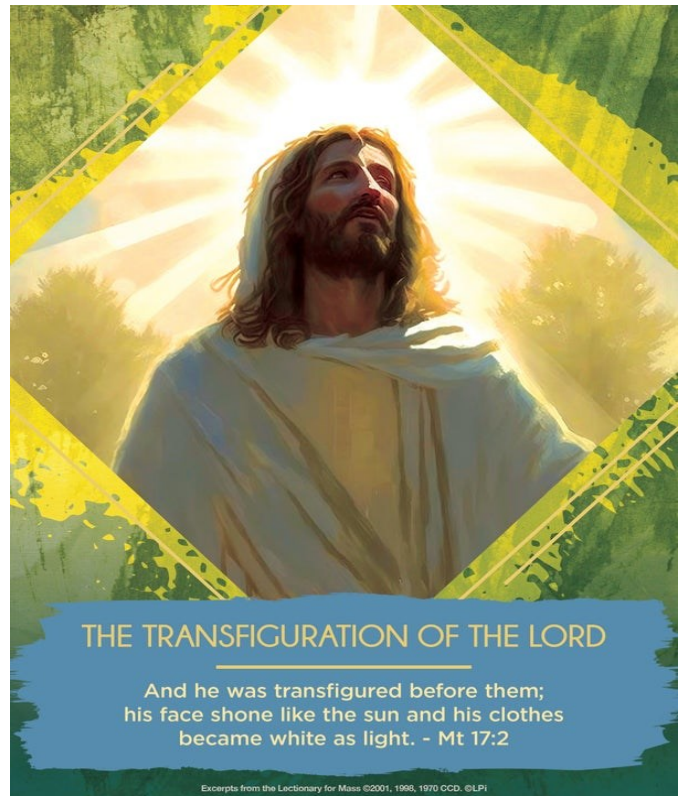

FAMILY UPDATES

2ND QUARTER FINANCIAL SUMMARY



This weekend you can find the second quarter financial report in the bulletin and on the family of parishes website. I want to thank all of you for your continued

financial support and the Family Finance Committee for their guidance, wisdom and leadership.

(1) SIGNS OF IMPROVEMENT

The good news is that regular offertory donations continue to improve. At the end of **June 2022 we had \$404,761 in donations** but at the end of **June 2023 we received \$478,841**. The average monthly collection in 2023 has been \$80,000 (as a family) versus \$67,000 in 2022. While collections are rising so are our costs with more ministry, increased utility rates in addition to building maintenance.

(2) MOVING FORWARD TOGETHER

The challenge before us is the continued ongoing deficit. Overall, at the **end of June 2023 we have reached a combined deficit of -\$119,000**. In June 2022, the deficit for the end of June was **-\$166,200**. This has prompted us to embark on our **IGNITE THE MISSION** discernment journey and enacting our new pastoral plan that will rejuvenate our efforts to form disciples who reach out to all. The status quo is not sustainable and change for us is already underway.

Please also note that we are still lacking a Family & Youth Coordinator and that we are getting closer to a full slate of ministries, programs and outreach which requires more volunteers and resources.

(3) NEXT STEPS

The summer has been a time for the pastoral team to plan for the upcoming year. There are a number of opportunities for all of us to grow as faithful and loving disciples. More to come very soon!!

The Pastoral Council and the Finance Committee will be taking time in August and early September to put together a draft **ACTION PLAN** in response to our **IGNITE THE MISSION** discernment and the vital information received via the feedback forms.

We are also waiting for further information and a message from Bishop Fabbro following his pastoral visit in June where he met with staff, Pastoral Council and Finance Committee. His direction and support will help us plan for the future following the vision set out for the entire diocese. The bishop is currently in consultation with senior diocesan leadership. More news to come!!



FAITHCATION RETREAT 2023

Our annual FAITHCATION retreat at the Holy Family Retreat Centre in Oxley, Ontario returns on the weekend of September, 29, 30 and October 1. Fr. 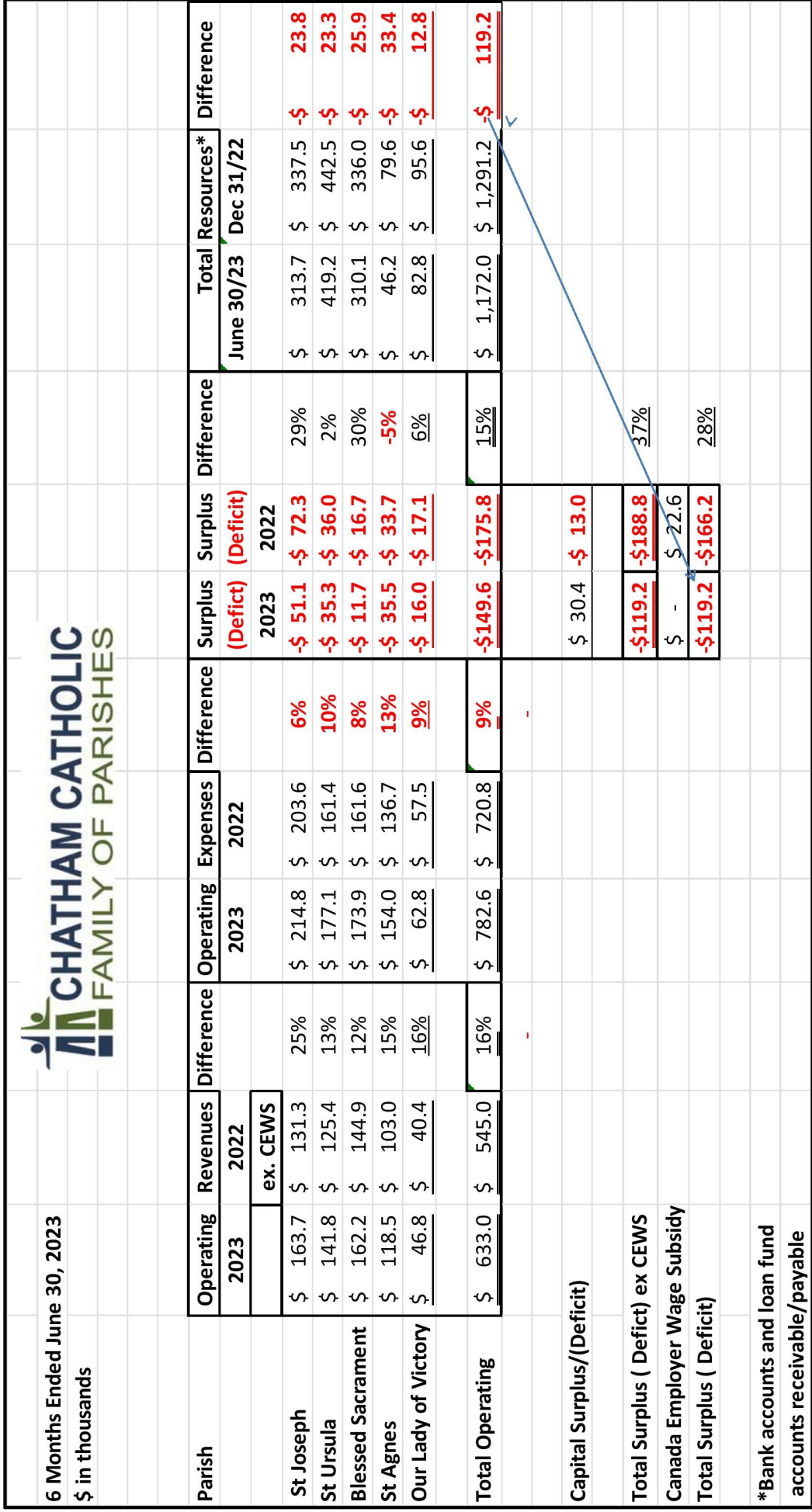
With this in mind, we as the Chatham Catholic Family of Parishes will be hosting a conference lead by a world renowned Catholic teacher, catechist, speaker and author from England—**David Wells**. I have had the privilege of being on a retreat lead by David a number of years ago with the principals of the Huron-Perth Catholic District School Board in addition to seeing him speak a few times at a Catholic education conference in Toronto and once in Anaheim, California.



This event is free but we are asking for a free-will offering (to be given at the event itself) for the catered lunch or the conference or both. I am opening this conference to our parishioners and volunteers, to all the families of parishes in the diocese and Catholic educators from our local Catholic school boards.

OVERALL— The total operating deficit for the Family was 15% better than the first 6 months of 2022. The removal of all COVID restrictions contributed to a 16% increase in Operating Revenues as church attendance improved. When combined with a 9% increase in Operating Expenses, the total **Operating Deficit was \$149.6 thousand** compared to **\$175.8 at June 30/22**. A

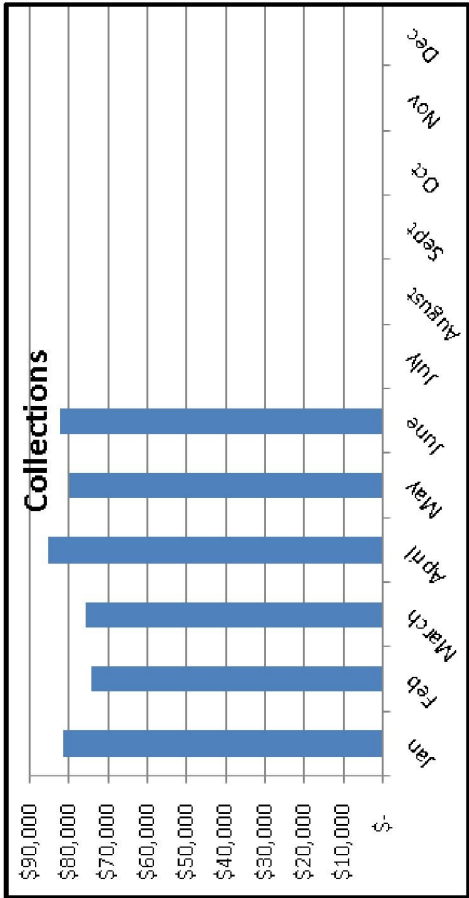
capital surplus this year of \$30.4 thousand lowered the overall deficit to \$119.2 thousand, 28% less than last year at this time. Last year's results included \$22.6 thousand for the last few months of the government COVID wage support program (CEWS).

OPERATING REVENUE— The main source of revenue is regular collections. **This amount increased from \$405 thousand last year to \$479 thousand this year, an increase of 18%.** The average monthly collections have been \$80 thousand this year vs. \$67 thousand in 2022. All parishes reported double digit increases in Operating Revenue so far this year, ranging from 12% to 25%.

OPERATING EXPENSES— The total expense increase of 9% for the Family was mainly driven by costs to maintain properties. This increase included some unexpected equipment repair costs as well as the growing cost of utilities. All parishes reported expense increases ranging from 6% to 13%. The average monthly expense total for the Family was \$130k for the first half of 2023.

CAPITAL— Capital spending has been kept to a minimum with the largest spending being the boiler replacement at Blessed Sacrament (which we have submitted an insurance claim for and hope to recoup some of the costs). As a result, there was a **capital surplus this year of \$30.4 thousand vs. a deficit of \$13.0 thousand in 2022.**

TOTAL RESOURCES— Total available resources to cover future deficits declined by \$119.2 thousand from December 31, 2022. **The total available was \$1.17 million at June 30, 2023.** All parishes reported a reduction in their total resources this year, with an average reduction of \$24 thousand per parish.
