TRUTH & RECONCILIATION FUNDRAISING LAUNCH

The Diocese of London is launching a fundraising campaign for the Truth and Reconciliation Fund with a special collection on the weekend of September 23/24, one week prior to National Day for Truth and Reconciliation ("Orange Shirt Day"). Bishop Fabbro has committed the Diocese to raising \$1.8 million over the next five years to support healing and reconciliation with Indigenous people.



ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

September 9 is the Feast Day of Blessed Frederic Ozanam who founded the Conference of Charity which later became known as the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. He was beatified in 1997. He was a man convinced of the inestimable worth of each human being. He served the poor of Paris and drew others into serving the poor of the world.

Thank you to the generous benefactors of Blessed Sacrament and St. Agnes parishes who contribute regularly through envelope donations, the Society continues the work of Frederick Ozanam here in Chatham. During the summer months donations of \$2,145.25 have been used to help 54 adults and 27 children.

On September 27 the faithful around the world celebrate the Feast Day of St. Vincent de Paul a man born into a poor French family who struggled to make ends meet. As we move into the fall season and celebrate Thanksgiving and our harvest of plenty let us look to these two faithful disciples who modeled Jesus in their love and concern for the poor in their midst.

“BECOMING A FAITHFUL DISCIPLE” CONFERENCE COMES TO CHATHAM

Our “IGNITE THE MISSION” discernment journey seeks to inspire but also position us as a faith community to most powerfully shift from maintenance to mission and Christendom to Apostolic Mission. We know that we are currently limited in our ability to evangelize, share and reach out to others so that they can encounter Jesus. To make this major shift, we will need to re-evaluate our priorities.



In order for us to move forward we need to understand what it means to be a disciple in our world today. This was clearly something brought up at our sharing sessions back in March and mentioned in a number of feedback forms. With this in mind, we as the Chatham Catholic Family of Parishes are hosting a conference lead by a world renowned Catholic teacher, catechist, speaker and author from England—**David Wells**. I have had the privilege of being on a retreat lead by David a number of years ago with the principals of the Huron-Perth Catholic District School Board in addition to seeing him speak a few times at a Catholic education conference in Toronto and once in Anaheim.

This event is free but we are asking for a free-will offering for the catered lunch or the conference or both. We have opened this conference to our parishioners and volunteers, to all the families of parishes in the diocese and Catholic educators from our local Catholic school boards.

The devotion to Mary, Undoer of Knots, has become more popular ever since Pope Francis encouraged the devotion in Argentina, and then spoke about it during his first year as pontiff.

The theology of the devotion actually goes back to the second century. St. Irenaeus wrote that, “The knot of Eve’s disobedience was untied by the obedience of Mary; what the virgin Eve bound by her unbelief, the Virgin Mary loosened by her faith.”

Mary’s faith unties the knot of sin. So, we will pray that the Blessed Virgin Mary will intercede for us all, to untie the knots of sin in our lives—so that we may be purified and ever closer to God.

WHAT IS A NOVENA?

THE WORD "NOVENA" MEANS NINE

The word "novena" comes from the Latin "novem" which means nine. Thus novenas always include nine of something: months, weeks, days, hours or even the same prayer repeated nine times.



DATES BACK TO THE APOSTLES

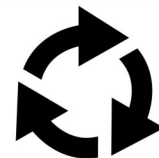
Novenas are an ancient tradition that goes back to the days of the Apostles. Jesus told His disciples to pray together after His ascension, so the Apostles along with Mary gathered to pray in the Upper Room during the nine days between the Ascension and Pentecost. (The first novena).

WHY PRAY A NOVENA?



When we pray a novena, we focus our attention intently on a special intention in order to receive special graces and either the answer to our prayers or discernment on what we need to do.

REPETITION BRINGS GROWTH



Repeating prayers and repeating them over time is helpful because we often need that length of time to move beyond merely making a request to learning to listen to God as He speaks to us in prayer. Nine days of prayer gives us time to consider more aspects of our prayer intention than just receiving an answer.

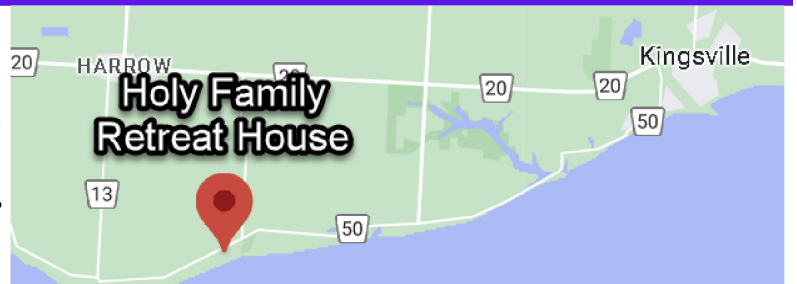

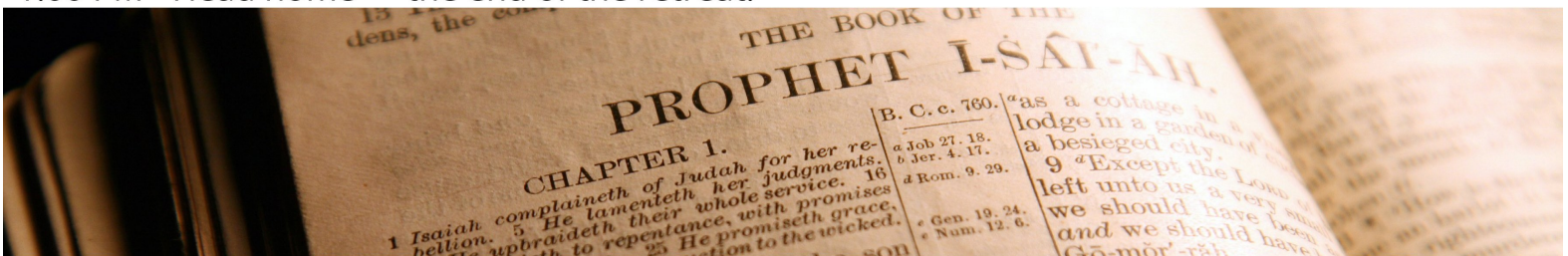
