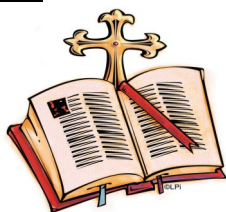

September 30, 2023 Financial Results Commentary – End of 3rd Quarter

OVERALL - September 30th marks the three quarter point in the year. The total operating deficit for the year was \$221 thousand, a 9% improvement compared to 2022. Operating revenues were up 12% compared to an expense increase of 7%. The lack of large capital spending produced a capital surplus of \$42 thousand. **The total deficit for the family was \$179 thousand, a 25% improvement over 2022, excluding the last few months of government COVID support.**

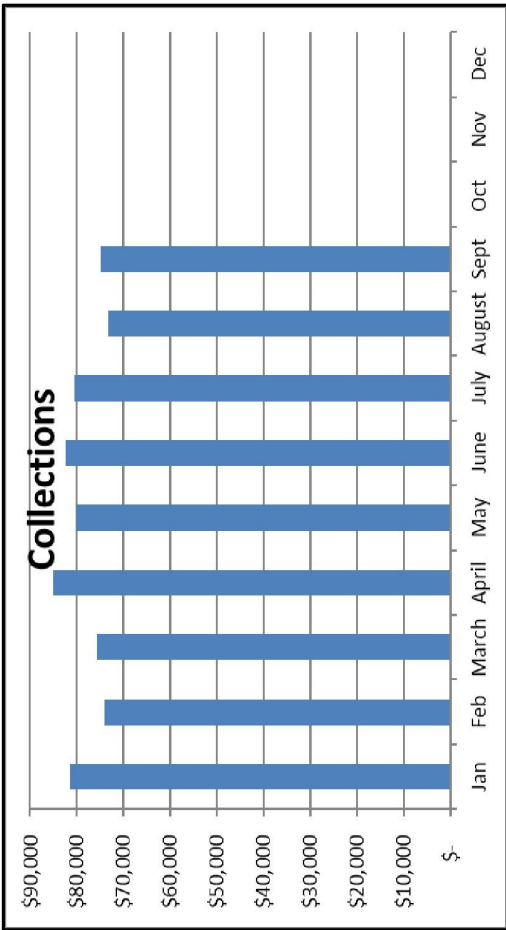
OPERATING REVENUE - Regular collections to September 30th were \$707 thousand, **12.5% more than last year.** Average monthly collections have been \$79 thousand this year, compared to \$70 thousand in 2022. All parishes reported an increase in total operating revenues, ranging from 8% to 19%. Total operating revenues were \$906 thousand.

OPERATING EXPENSES - Total operating expenses have grown by 7% so far in 2023 to reach \$1.1 million. The total cost to maintain all the buildings in the family was \$358 thousand, an increase of 14.6% over last year, due in part to equipment repairs and utilities.

TOTAL RESOURCES - Total funds available in the family decreased by \$179 thousand from December 31/22 to the end of September 2023. The total family resources were \$1.1 million at September 30, 2023. All parishes reported a reduction in total resources, ranging from \$20 thousand to \$47 thousand.

THINGS TO REMEMBER - Pastoral Council, Finance Committee and the Pastoral Team are working on a plan to move forward as we slowly dialogue with Bishop Fabbro and diocesan senior leadership seeking some further clarity and answers to important questions. Please note that as we continue to run a deficit (thankful for the increased donations), parishes are rapidly losing funds. St. Agnes only has \$32,200 in total net assets as of the end of September 2023.

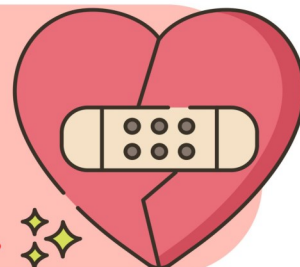
