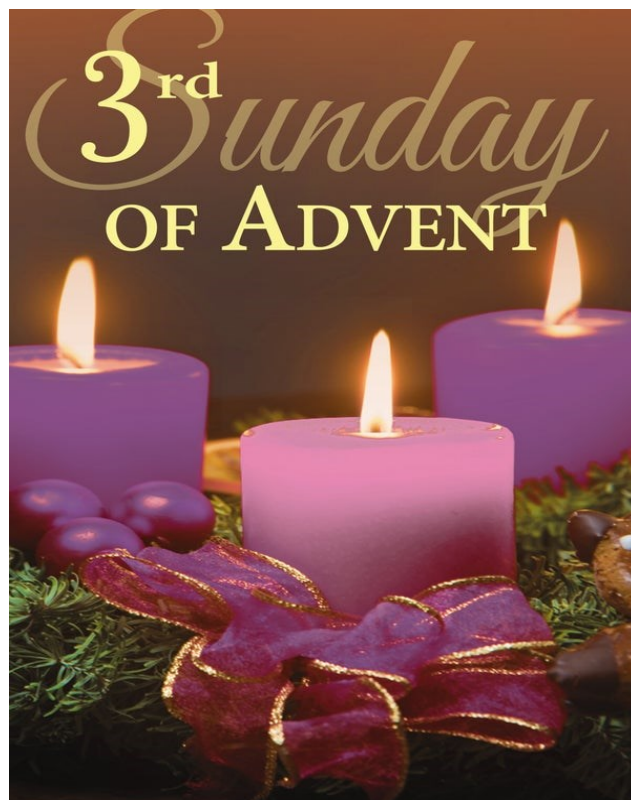

FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT & CHRISTMAS

As you may have noticed, the Fourth Sunday of Advent falls on Sunday December 24th. Some people have asked about the Masses that weekend and how they relate to Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.

Saturday night December 23rd and Sunday morning of December 24th are considered the Fourth Sunday of Advent and so we have a regular weekend Mass schedule. Beginning with the late Sunday afternoon Masses—we begin the Christmas season.

So the expectation is that we are all called to attend the Fourth Sunday of Advent preparing the way for the Lord and then of course, celebrate Christmas (on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day) which is a holy day of obligation in Canada (along with every weekend).

The only other holy day of obligation in Canada outside of weekend Masses and Christmas is January 1st (New Year's Eve and New Year's Day as we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God).

I am very thankful to all the liturgical ministers, decorators and musicians who have made our Advent journey so meaningful and our upcoming Christmas celebrations truly opportunities to welcome Christ.

SPARKS OF HOPE SHINE FORTH



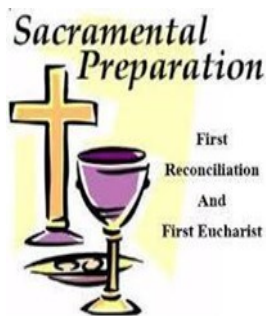
