





### **OUR FAMILY LENTEN JOURNEY: WEEK TWO**











When you love someone, you usually want to spend time with that person. That is how you get to know each other. Jesus loves each one of us and wants you to spend time with Him every day, especially during Lent. One way you can do this is to find a quiet place to <u>pray</u> and invite Jesus to sit with you.

### **LECTIO DIVINA**

Praying with God's Word in the Bible is a wonderful way to get to know Jesus. There is a special guided meditation called "Lectio Divina' which means 'divine reading.' To use this method of prayer you can follow these easy steps.

<u>READ</u>

<u>THINK</u>

**PRAY** 

**LISTEN** 





Find a quiet place to sit away from noise and distractions. Choose a passage from the Bible to read. It might be the Gospel for Sunday. Read the passage slowly, at least three times. You might need someone to help you read. Sometimes it helps to read it out loud.



What is happening in the story? What do you see? What do you hear? What words or phrases jump out to you? What is this story saying to you? What do you think you are learning from God's Word? What do you think Jesus might be teaching you?



It's time to talk to God or Jesus. What would you like to say to God? What do you need help understanding? What would you thank God for? What questions do you have about this story?



Now it's time to sit quietly and rest while you listen to what God wants to say to you. You can ask God, "What change are you asking me to make after hearing Your Word? Write it down. Thank God!



Maybe you can use this passage to try Lectio Divina....Mark 9:2-10

After six days, Jesus took Peter, James and John with him. They went up a high mountain. Suddenly, Jesus looked different. His clothes became so white they shone. Then all of a sudden, two prophets that had died long ago, appeared. They were Moses and Elijah. They began to talk with Jesus. Peter said to Jesus, "Teacher, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three tents. One will be for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." Peter didn't know what to say because he and James and John were so afraid. Then a cloud appeared and covered them. A voice came from the cloud, saying,

"THIS IS MY SON AND I LOVE HIM. LISTEN TO HIM."

Peter, James and John looked around. Suddenly, they no longer saw anyone with them except Jesus. As they came down the mountain, Jesus ordered them not to tell anyone what they had seen. He told them to wait until the Son of Man had risen from the dead. So they kept quiet but they asked each other, what does 'rising from the dead mean?'

Prayer is like having a conversation or chat with a good friend. God asks you to talk to Him about anything. The more you spend time with God, the more you become a prayer super STAR! You can use these kinds of prayers:



Show honour and praise to God.

Thank God for your blessings.



God, I thank you today for Jesus, thank you for Holy Spirit I give thanks for \_\_\_\_\_



Ask God for your needs and others' needs.




God, please help me Jesus, my friend needs Holy Spirit, hear my prayer for\_\_\_



Reconcile with God. Say you are sorry to God and others. Pray for your enemies.



God, I am sorry I Jesus, please forgive me for \_\_\_\_\_\_ Holy Spirit, help me forgive \_\_\_\_\_



Romans 12:1 "Therefore I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God -- this is your true and proper worship."

Lent is a time for you to become the best you can be. You can make changes so you can be more loving and a better disciple for Jesus. One way is to pray with your body.

- EYES- Let me see your face in others and recognize their needs. Help me use my eyes to learn more about the way you want me to live
- EARS- Let me listen to your Word through my parents, my teachers and my church. Close my ears to gossip and lies.
- LIPS-Let me always tell the truth. Give me courage to speak up for others who do not have a voice. Help me share your Word with others so they might learn about your love through me..
- FEET-Let me answer your call when you say "Follow Me". Help me go to places where you need me to work with others. Help me stay away from situations that will harm me. Keep me on the right path.
- HANDS-Let me use my hands to comfort, to help, to bless, to hold others. Let your hands be my hands to offer peace not hate.


