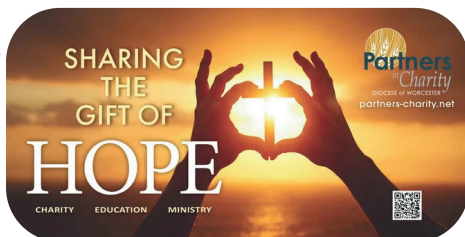

Dear Parish Family,

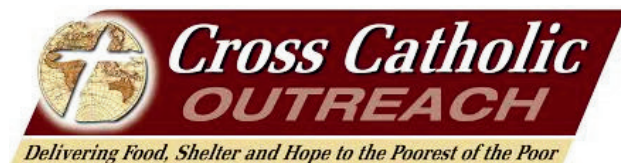
This weekend we warmly welcome Father Gabriel Lormeus. Father Gabriel Lormeus was ordained to the priesthood in 1986 and is a priest of the Archdiocese of Cap-Haitien, Haiti. He holds a bachelor's degree in theology. His pastoral experience includes working in trauma centers, Intensive Care Units and Surgical Intensive Care Units; he possesses a Clinical Pastoral Education Unit 1 license and volunteers for Vitas Health Care while working toward completing his license at Jackson Memorial Hospital in Florida. His pastoral work involves celebrating Mass throughout the Archdiocese of Miami and the Diocese of Palm Beach, and he is a weekly presider at St. Malachy Church in Tamarac, Florida. Until 2014, he held the role of vicar at St. Mary and St. Ann parishes in the Archdiocese of Boston. He is fluent in French, Creole and English.

We are blessed to be hosting Father Gabriel Lormeus who is representing Cross Catholic Outreach this weekend. This official Catholic ministry was founded to link parishes in the United States with priests, religious brothers and sisters, and lay people working in Church missions overseas. 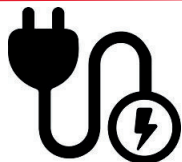
