# Catechist Background

What parts of your life are hidden in darkness?

The Son of God came into the world to free us from sin and to show us what God's love is like. Through Jesus' words and actions, we see God's love at work. In the Gospel of John, Jesus tells his followers, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (John 8:12).

At our Baptism we received a candle lit from the Paschal candle, which symbolized the light of Christ. We were told to keep this light burning and to walk always as children of the light. We receive the light of Christ both as a gift of light in our own life and as a symbol of who we are to become. As followers of Christ, our words and actions are meant to give witness to the one light of the world, Jesus Christ.

One important way we become light for the world is as peacemakers. In a world torn by violence, hatred, and despair, we try to live in peace

We become light for the world when all that we do brings wisdom and warmth to those around us.






