Today's Reflection:  
Fourth Sunday of Easter

Jesus said: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." The disinformation and conspiracy theories that plague our culture make it harder to hear the truth in Christ's voice. We've always had people on the fringe who bought into all kinds of crazy theories. The earth is flat. The government faked the moon landing. Elvis is alive. But now our political culture is infected with these sorts of theories and we are suffering serious consequences.

Last week U. S. Representative Marjorie Taylor Greene, a former Catholic, said in a television interview that Catholic bishops are Satanists. She claims they

are destroying America by supporting illegal immigration and making personal fortunes. Previously, she claimed that a group of wealthy Jews used satellites to manipulate Dominion voting machines and stole the last presidential election. MS Greene propagates several other conspiracy theories about the Covid vaccine and denies the reality of school shootings. The problem is that people believe her.

The truth of Christ leads to the fullness of life. The falsehoods spread by people like Marjorie Taylor Greene leads to Insurrection and death. Her anti-Catholic rhetoric encourages vandalism like the kind we have already experienced at our parish or worse, violence. We are Christ's sheep, but we can't be sheepish in our defense of the truth. The presidential election was not stolen. Our bishops are not Satanists and the world is not flat.
