Today's Reflection

I was an altar boy before the Second Vatican Council. I memorized the Mass in Latin, Et cum spiritu tuo, the whole thing. The only problem? I didn't understand a single word I was saying. After Vatican II, people jokingly referred to the old liturgy as the Mass of Universal Ignorance. You could walk into any Catholic church in the world and hear the same words, but not understand them. It was like living in the shadow of the Tower of Babel: the punishment for trying to become God. Pentecost, then, is God's reversal, a moment of redemption.

In today's reading from Acts, people from every corner of the known world hear the apostles in their own languages. How? I'm not sure, maybe a miraculous version of the United Nations translator booth. But the meaning is clear: the Gospel is meant for everyone, in every language, in every culture.

And yet, today, how do we preach across our modern Babel; across political divides, generational gaps, economic inequalities? How do I, as someone raised on Latin and incense, speak the same message to a Gen Z TikToker? The answer isn't easy. But Pentecost reminds us: it's possible. The Holy Spirit gives us what we need, not just tongues, but understanding. Courage. Creativity. Mercy. We are a missionary Church, and the Second Vatican Council challenges us to undo Babel. One honest word, one loving voice, at a time.

Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession: Tower Bridge to the Cathedral

Reflection from Pope Leo XIV

Celebrating his first Mass in Rome's diocesan cathedral, Pope Leo XIV said communion is built primarily "on our knees," through prayer and a constant commitment to conversion. He reaffirmed Pope Francis' dedication to listening, first and foremost to the Holy Spirit, as it then leads to listening to and understanding others "as our brothers and sisters."

Speaking from the window of the Apostolic Palace, the pope said, "Let us resolve to bring (the Lord's) love everywhere, never forgetting that each of our sisters and brothers is a dwelling place of God and that his presence is manifested above all in the little ones, in the poor and the suffering, who ask us to be thoughtful and compassionate Christians."
