Today's Reflection

In today's Gospel, Jesus feeds a crowd of 5,000. But let's look not just at the miracle, but at the role of the disciples. They don't perform miracles themselves. Instead, they do something very human, and very holy: they ask, they receive, and they share. We are invited to do the same.

Beginning this weekend and running through July 14, our St. Vincent de Paul Society will collect non-perishable food to help local families in need. In our 95820 ZIP code. approximately 10,000 children live in poverty, well above the county average. With school out for the summer, many children who rely on free or reduced lunch programs face an added burden: hunger.

We may not be able to perform miracles, but we can be disciples. Each weekend, you'll find collection bins in the church vestibule. We are especially seeking: Canned meats (tuna, chicken, corned beef, Spam), Staples (rice, beans, lentils, guinoa, pasta, pasta sauce), Breakfast items (cereal, oatmeal, pancake mix, peanut butter, jelly). and **Canned vegetables** (corn, peas, beets). All donations will be delivered weekly to the Western Service Workers Association on Perry Avenue, who will distribute them directly to neighborhood families in need. Thank you for sharing what you can. And may God bless you for your generosity.

From Pope Leo XIV

Pope Leo XIV's Homily Closing the Jubilee of Sport: Pope Leo remembered Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, the patron saint of athletes, who will be canonized on September 7 this year. He pointed out that Frassati's life shows us that "no one is born a champion, no one is born a saint." It is a daily training and takes us one step closer to our final championship.

Closing, Pope Leo XIV challenged the athletes present with a mission: "to reflect in all your activities the love of the Triune God, for your own good and for that of your brothers and sisters." Urging them to entrust themselves to Mary, who will help guide them towards the "greatest victory of all: the prize of eternal life."
