Today's Reflection

Pope Leo XIV reminded us that the Church is missionary by nature. It's easy to picture missionaries as priests, brothers. or sisters sent to faraway lands. But today's Gospel tells a broader story: Jesus appoints 72 disciples to go out in pairs, not ordained or in religious vows, but ordinary disciples, men, and women alike. That call extends to us. Through baptism, each of us becomes a missionary. Yet we may hesitate. We're not likely to knock on doors or quote scripture to strangers. Still, the mission remains.

I remember two kind women visiting my home, eager to read Bible verses. I declined politely, but they read them anyway. In contrast to a St. Vincent de Paul home visitation, we offer to pray with neighbors, but if they decline, we respect their wishes. Being a missionary begins with listening. We proclaim Christ with words and through acts of mercy, supporting Catholic Charities, visiting the sick, and serving through other organizations. We share the Gospel through how we love.

But how do we do this in the age of artificial intelligence. an age where connection is increasingly digital, and faceto-face encounters are rare? How do we "go out in pairs" when the community feels virtual? That's the challenge. And maybe the invitation: to find new ways to bring human presence, compassion, and Christ's love into a world that's forgetting how to look each other in the eye.
