# Today's Reflection

After 30 years of teaching high school religion students, I can say there were things I loved, and things that drove me crazy. One of my biggest pet peeves? When I corrected a student, a friend jumped in to defend them. I'd say, "Put your gum in the basket," and a friend would chime in, "She's not chewing gum!" I'd grumble, "She doesn't need a lawyer or a translator. Stay out of it."

Abraham reminds me a little of those meddling students. God judges Sodom and Gomorrah in today's first reading, and Abraham audaciously intervenes. "Will you sweep away the righteous with the wicked?" he asks. And then he starts negotiating with God, not for his own people, but for strangers and foreigners. Amazingly, God listens. It tells us God is not only just, but merciful. That prayer isn't a private whisper; it's a courageous plea for justice and mercy.

We live in a world swirling with cruelty, conflict, and digital noise that amplifies despair, especially among the young. Like Abraham, we're called to speak up, to intervene, and to believe that even in judgment, mercy has the final word. Would I be more patient today with those teenage "lawyers"? Maybe. But I'd still want that gum in the basket.
