Today's Reflection

In today's Gospel, Jesus says, “Do not be afraid any longer . . .” It's a phrase we hear again and again in Scripture. Whenever God sends a messenger, the first words are often, “Do not be afraid.” The assumption is always the same: the person is already terrified. And I understand that. Even prayer, when it feels real, when I sense God is truly present, can be overwhelming. If God is listening, then this isn't just routine. It's sacred. It's serious. And it's not always easy.

How do we move past fear? Our first two readings point us toward faith. Think of Mary. The angel Gabriel appears with a life-altering message. She asks questions. But then she says yes, her fear transformed by faith into courage.

I once made a private list of my fears. It was long. Fear for my family's safety. Fear of failing people I love. And today, fear for the countless immigrants among us, documented and undocumented, who live in quiet terror every day. On the news, I saw a mother being taken from her car by masked men, while her child watched. That image haunts me.

What can I do? I can pray, for them, for us, for the courage to love boldly. Prayer isn't passive. It changes us. It gives strength to those we lift up. And it draws us closer to the God who still whispers, even now: “Do not be afraid any longer...

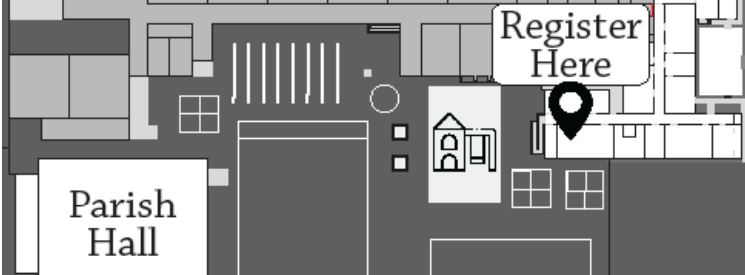
