# Today's Reflection

"Who can know God's counsel, or who can conceive what the Lord intends?" (Wis 9:13) What a question. The Book of Wisdom tosses it our way like a holy curveball. But here's the good news: while God's will isn't always easy to grasp, it is possible to discern, through grace, patience, and faithfulness.

I was blessed to be formed by the Holy Cross Fathers. Their approach wove together Scripture, sacraments, Church teachings, and quiet time in monasteries. I wasn't lost exactly, but I was definitely searching. That season of discernment was deep, but it didn't stop there—because listening for God's voice is a lifelong journey. We discover God's will in everyday moments: in prayer, in the Eucharist, in genuine conversations, and in reflecting honestly on our lives. Scripture is a compass. Today's Psalm teaches us to number our days wisely. Paul reminds Philemon that love, not productivity, is our highest calling. And Jesus? He's direct: discipleship costs everything. There's no discount aisle. No shortcuts. Just the cross, and the promise that it's worth it.

This Gospel brings us back to what matters: simplicity, courage, and generosity. And I see that right here, in the quiet consistency of our ministers and volunteers, the fierce compassion of our St. Vincent de Paul team, and your ongoing care for those in need. Some curveballs are meant to be hit.


### Faith Formation
