Today's Reflection

In today's Gospel, ten lepers are healed, but only one returns to thank Jesus. And who is it? The outsider, the Samaritan. The one least expected to show gratitude. If Jesus told this story today, maybe the "lepers" would be the people we push to the margins: the homeless person at the stoplight, the refugee family we're told to fear, the incarcerated, the mentally ill, the elderly, or the disabled. We may not have miraculous healing powers, but we do have something powerful: each other.

We have our Loaves and Fishes, our St. Vincent de Paul, our food banks, our ministries to the imprisoned. We have Pope Leo and our bishops calling us to welcome the stranger and defend the dignity of the vulnerable, no matter their legal status. We have hospitals, charities, even government programs we can support. No one person can do everything, but together, we can do something Christlike. We can also be Samaritan-like.

I write down what I'm thankful for each morning, and the page is never blank. I even use my Rosary beads to pray in thanksgiving, naming each person and event that blesses my life. Want a challenge? Try naming 50 people or things you're grateful for using your rosary. Bead by bead, blessing by blessing, you'll feel the Samaritans's gratitude long before you finish your rosary. Jesus still heals.
