## Today's Reflection

On this Second Sunday of Easter, the first words the Risen Christ speaks to His disciples are, "Peace be with you." Though this may sound like a simple greeting, it carries a far deeper meaning. Pope Leo said that peace is both a gift and a responsibility. It comes from God—flowing into our hearts—but it must also move outward, shaping how we live with one another.

This peace begins within us and extends to our families, our friends, our communities, and ultimately our world. In a time when peace is absent, we are called to listen carefully to what Jesus teaches. Peace is not passive; it is something we must actively choose, nurture, and protect.

Yet we hear voices of our political and even religious leaders—who invoke the name of Christ to justify violence and war. This stands in stark contradiction to Jesus, the Prince of Peace. As Pope Leo reminded us: "This is our God: Jesus, King of Peace, who rejects war... no one can use Him to justify it."

With wars raging across our world, I pray with St. Pope John Paul II, "Mary, Queen of Peace, save us from war, hatred, and oppression. Teach us to live in peace, to act with justice, and to respect the dignity of every person, so that true peace may be firmly established." Amen.
