Fr. Brendan McKeefry a beloved priest of the Diocese of Sacramento passed away on Monday, June 22, 2026. Fr McKeefry served in our Diocese for 41 years at Holy Spirit Parish, Fairfield; All Hallows, Sacramento; Saint John the Baptist, Chico; Saint Thomas More, Paradise; Good Shepherd, Elk Grove; and finally to Our Lady of the Assumption, Carmichael.

Father McKeefry served at All Hallows Parish from 1981 - December 1989.

All are invited to celebrate Fr McKeefry's life and years of service, with a **Funeral service at Our Lady of Assumption Parish, Wednesday July 1st at 11:00am.**

A viewing will be held in the church the day before between 4 - 7pm, followed by a Funeral Vigil Service at 7pm. In lieu of flowers, donations in honor of Fr. Brendan may be made to OLA St. Vincent de Paul.

Today's Reflection

Our first reading from the Book of Kings centers on a woman of influence, yet she is never named. That is not unusual in Scripture. Women are often identified as someone’s wife, mother, or daughter rather than as individuals in their own right. Their contributions are present, but frequently under-recognized.

Pope Leo XIV addresses this challenge in his first encyclical, Magnificat Humanitas: “It is not enough to state simply that men and women have equal dignity and rights; it is necessary that this be reflected in concrete decisions.” Equal dignity must be more than a principle; it must be a lived reality.

Recent developments in the Church suggest progress. In 2025, Pope Francis appointed Sister Simona Brambilla as the first woman to lead a Vatican dicastery, overseeing religious congregations worldwide. He also named Sister Raffaella Petrini governor of Vatican City State, another historic first. Earlier this year, Pope Leo appointed Maria Montserrat Alvarado, a laywoman, to head the Dicastery for Communications.

I recall a religious education conference in the 1990s. A teacher asked a cardinal, “What can I tell my gifted female students about becoming leaders in the Church?” His reply was brief: “Tell them to be patient.” The woman seated next to me whispered, “We’ve been patient for 2,000 years.” Perhaps that patience is beginning to pay off. The question for us is whether our own parishes, ministries, and families recognize, encourage, and make room for the gifts God has given to women.

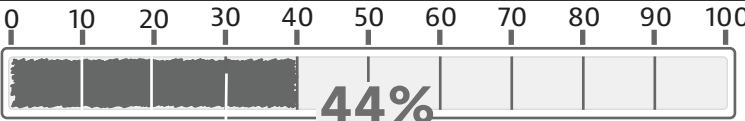
